*We cannot promise to stop proclaiming what we have seen and heard.*


Responsorial Psalm: **I will thank you, Lord, for you have given answer.**

Gospel Acclamation: **Alleluia, alleluia! This day was made by the Lord; we rejoice and are glad. Alleluia!**

Gospel: Mark 16:9-15

*Go out to the whole world: proclaim the Good News.*

Communion Antiphon: **All of you who have been baptised in Christ have put on Christ, alleluia.**



**EASTER OCTAVE**



**Monday, 17<sup>th</sup> April**

**EASTER MONDAY**

Entrance Antiphon: **The Lord has led you into a land flowing with milk and honey, that the law of the Lord may always be on your lips, alleluia.**

The **Gloria** is said.

First Reading: Acts 2:14. 22-33

*God raised this man Jesus to life, and all of us are witnesses to that.*

Responsorial Psalm: **Preserve me, Lord, I take refuge in you.**

Gospel Acclamation: **Alleluia, alleluia! This day was made by the Lord; we rejoice and are glad. Alleluia!**

Gospel: Matthew 28:8-15

*Tell my brothers that they must leave for Galilee; they will see me there.*

Communion Antiphon: **Christ, having risen from the dead, dies now no more; death will no longer have dominion over him, alleluia.**

**Tuesday, 18<sup>th</sup> April**

**EASTER TUESDAY**

Entrance Antiphon: **He gave them the water of wisdom to drink; it will be made strong in them and will not be moved; it will raise them up forever, alleluia.**

The **Gloria** is said.

First Reading: Acts 2:36-41

*You must repent and every one of you must be baptised in the name of Jesus.*

Responsorial Psalm: **The Lord fills the earth with his love.**

The Sequence may be used.

Gospel Acclamation: **Alleluia, Alleluia! This day was made by the Lord; we rejoice and are glad**

Gospel: John 20:11-18

*I have seen the Lord and he has spoken to me.*

Communion Antiphon: **If you have risen with Christ, seek the things that are above, where Christ is seated at the right hand of God; mind the things that are above, alleluia.**

**Wednesday, 19<sup>th</sup> April**

**EASTER WEDNESDAY**

Entrance Antiphon: **Come, you blessed of my Father; receive the kingdom prepared for you from the foundation of the world, alleluia.**

The **Gloria** is said.

First Reading: Acts 3:1-10

*I will give you what I have: in the name of Jesus stand up and walk.*

Responsorial Psalm: **Let the hearts that seek the Lord rejoice.**

Gospel Acclamation: **Alleluia, alleluia! This day was made by the Lord; we rejoice and are glad. Alleluia!**

Gospel: Luke 24:13-35

*They recognised Jesus at the breaking of the bread.*

Communion Antiphon: **The disciples recognised the Lord Jesus in the breaking of the bread, alleluia.**

**Thursday 20<sup>th</sup> April**

**EASTER THURSDAY**

Entrance Antiphon: **They praised in unison your conquering hand, O Lord, for wisdom opened mouths that were mute and gave eloquence to the tongues of infants, alleluia.**

The **Gloria** is said.

First Reading: Acts 3:11-26

*You killed the prince of life. God, however, raised him from the dead.*

Responsorial Psalm: **How great is your name, O Lord our God, through all the earth.**

Gospel Acclamation: **Alleluia, alleluia! This day was made by the Lord; we rejoice and are glad. Alleluia!**

Gospel: Luke 24:35-48

*It is written that the Christ would suffer and on the third day rise from the dead.*

Communion Antiphon: **O chosen people, proclaim the mighty works of him, who called you out of darkness into his wonderful light, alleluia.**

**Friday, 21st April**

**EASTER FRIDAY**

Entrance Antiphon: **The Lord led his people in hope, while the sea engulfed their foes, alleluia.**

The **Gloria** is said.

First Reading: Acts 4:1-12

*This is the only name by which we can be saved.*

Responsorial Psalm: **The stone which the builders rejected has become the corner stone.**

Gospel Acclamation: **Alleluia, alleluia! This day was made by the Lord; we rejoice and are glad. Alleluia!**

Gospel: John 21:1-14

*Jesus stepped forward, took the bread and gave it to them, and the same with the fish.*
