

Saturday, 20<sup>th</sup> May

**Weekday in Easter or  
St Bernadine of Siena, Priest, Religious,  
Missionary.**

*Bernadine was a Franciscan missionary, reformer, popular preacher, peacemaker, called 'the Apostle of Italy,' who died in 1444, aged 63.*

**Entrance Antiphon: You have been buried with Christ in Baptism, through which you also rose again by faith in the working of God, who raised him from the dead, alleluia.**

**First Reading: Acts 16:1-10**  
*Come across to Macedonia and help us.*

**Responsorial Psalm: Your friends O Lord, shall make known the glorious splendour of your reign.**

**Gospel Acclamation: Alleluia, alleluia! It was ordained that the Christ should suffer and rise from the dead, and so enter into his glory. Alleluia!**

**Gospel: John 15:18-21**  
*You do not belong to the world because my choice withdrew you from the world.*

**Communion Antiphon: Father, I pray for them, that they may be one in us, so that the world may believe it was you who sent me, says the Lord, alleluia.**

# WEEKDAY MASS SHEET

**15<sup>th</sup> May – 20<sup>th</sup> May  
Easter Week Five**

**Monday, 15<sup>th</sup> May**

**Entrance Antiphon: The good shepherd has risen, who laid down his life for his sheep and willingly died for his flock, alleluia**

**First Reading: Acts 14:5-18**  
*We have come with good news to make you turn from these empty idols to the living God.*

**Responsorial Psalm: Not to us, lord, but to your name give the glory. Alleluia!**

**Gospel Acclamation: Alleluia, alleluia! Christ has risen and shone upon us whom he redeemed with his blood. Alleluia!**

**Gospel: John 14:21-26**  
*The Advocate, whom the Father will send in my name, will teach you everything.*

**Communion Antiphon: Peace I leave you; my peace I give you. Not as the world gives do I give it to you, says the Lord, alleluia.**

**Tuesday, 16<sup>th</sup> May**

**Weekday of Easter**

**Entrance Antiphon: Sing praise to our God, all you who fear God, both small and great, for now salvation and strength have come, and the power of his Christ, alleluia.**

**First Reading: Acts 14:19-28**  
*They gave an account to the church of all that God had done with them.*

**Responsorial Psalm: Your friends, O Lord, shall make known the glorious splendour of your reign.**

**Gospel Acclamation: Alleluia, alleluia! It was ordained that the Christ should suffer and rise from the dead, and so enter into his glory. Alleluia!**

Gospel: John 21-26

*The Advocate, whom the Father will send in my name, will teach you everything.*

Communion Antiphon: **Peace I leave you; my peace I give you. Not as the world gives do I give it to you, says the Lord, alleluia.**

**Wednesday, 17<sup>th</sup> May**

**Weekday of Easter**

Entrance Antiphon: **Let my mouth be filled with your praise, that I may sing aloud; my lips shall shout for joy, when I sing to you, alleluia.**

First Reading: Acts 15:1-6

*It was arranged that they should go up to Jerusalem and discuss the problem with the apostles and elders.*

Responsorial Psalm: **I rejoiced when I heard them say: 'Let us go to God's house.'**

Gospel Acclamation: **Alleluia, alleluia! I am the good shepherd, says the Lord, I know my sheep and my own know me. Alleluia!**

Gospel: John 15:1-8

*Whoever remains in me, with me in him, bears fruit in plenty.*

Communion Antiphon: **The Lord has risen and shone his light upon us, whom he has redeemed by his Blood, alleluia.**

**Thursday, 18<sup>th</sup> May**

**Weekday of Easter or**

**St John I, Pope and Martyr**

*A short pontificate of three years, John tried to reconcile the Eastern Emperor and the Gothic King. He died in 526.*

Entrance Antiphon: **Let us sing to the Lord, for he has gloriously triumphed. The Lord is my strength and my might; he has become my salvation, alleluia.**

First Reading: Acts 15:7-21

*I rule that we do not make things difficult for pagans who turn to God.*

Responsorial Psalm: **Proclaim the wonders of the Lord among all the peoples.**

Gospel Acclamation: **Alleluia, alleluia! Christ has risen: he who created all things, and has granted his mercy to men. Alleluia!**

Gospel: John 15:9-11

*Remain in my love, and let your joy be complete.*

Communion Antiphon: **Christ died for all, that those who live may live no longer for themselves, but for him who died for them and is risen, alleluia**

**Friday, 19<sup>th</sup> May**

**Weekday in Easter or**

**St Dunstan, Bishop**

*Dunstan died in 988, a Benedictine monk who was appointed Archbishop of Canterbury. He was a confidante of Kings and did much to restore Benedictive monasticism.*

Entrance Antiphon: **Worthy is the lamb who was slain, to receive power and divinity, and wisdom and strength and honour, alleluia.**

First Reading: Acts 16:1-10

*Come across to Macedonia and help us.*

Responsorial Psalm: **Cry out with joy to the Lord, all the earth.**

Gospel Acclamation: **Alleluia, alleluia! The Lord who hung for us upon the tree, has risen from the tomb. Alleluia!**

Gospel: John 15:18-21

*You do not belong to the world because my choice withdrew you from the world.*

Communion Antiphon: **The crucified is risen from the dead and has redeemed us, alleluia.**
