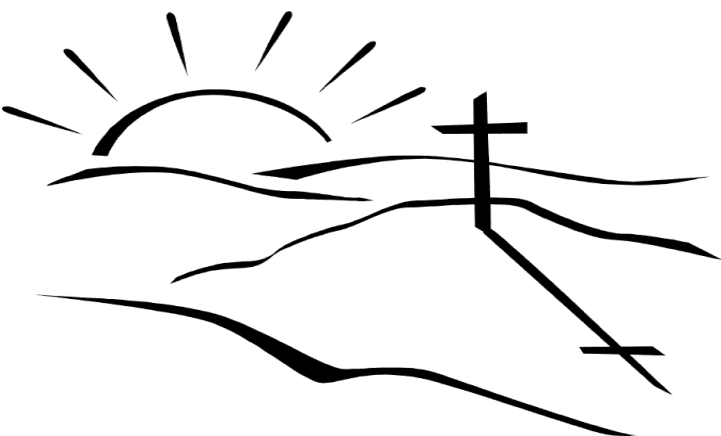
First Reading: **Maccabees 7:1-2. 9-14**
We are prepared to die rather than break the laws of our ancestors.

Responsorial Psalm: **Our Life, like a bird, has escaped from the snare of the fowler.**

Gospel Acclamation: **Alleluia, alleluia! How happy are the poor in spirit; theirs is the kingdom of heaven. Alleluia!**

Gospel: Matthew 5: 1-12
Rejoice and be glad, for your reward will be great in Heaven.

Communion Antiphon: **How precious in the eyes of the Lord is the death of his holy ones.**

Monday, 29th May

SOLEMNITY OF THE DEDICATION

Entrance Antiphon: **Greatly to be feared is God in his sanctuary; he, the god of Israel, gives power and strength to his people. Blessed be God!**

The **GLORIA** is said.

First Reading: Apocalypse 21:1-5
Here God lives among men.

Responsorial Psalm: **How lovely is your dwelling place, Lord, God of hosts.**

Gospel Acclamation: **Alleluia, alleluia! I shall make my home among them, says the Lord; I will be their God, they shall be my people, Alleluia!**

Gospel: 4:19-24
True worshippers will worship the Father in spirit and truth. The **CREED** is said.

Communion Antiphon: **You are the temple of God, and God's spirit dwells in you. The temple of God is holy. You are that temple.**

In non-consecrated Churches

Entrance Antiphon: **The Lord became my protector. He brought me out to a place of freedom; he saved me because he delighted in me.**

First Reading: Acts 19:1-8
Did you receive the Holy Spirit when you became believers?

Responsorial Psalm: **Kingdoms of the earth, sing to God.**

Gospel Acclamation: **Alleluia, alleluia! I came from the Father and have come into the world, and now I leave the world to go to the Father. Alleluia!**

Gospel: John 16:29-33
Be brave: I have conquered the world.

Communion Antiphon: **I will not leave you orphans, says the Lord; I will come to you again, and your heart will rejoice, alleluia.**

Tuesday, 30th May
Weekday of Easter

Entrance Antiphon: **I am the first and the last. I was dead and am now alive. Behold, I am alive forever and ever, Alleluia.**

First Reading: Acts 20:17-27
I am finishing my race and carrying out the mission the Lord Jesus gave me.

Responsorial Psalm: **Kingdoms of the earth, sing to God.**

Gospel Acclamation: **Alleluia, alleluia! I will not leave you orphans, says the Lord; I go, but I will come back to you, and your hearts will be full of joy. Alleluia!**

Gospel: John 17:1-11
Father, glorify your Son.

Communion Antiphon: **The Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in my name, will teach you all things and remind you of all I have told you, says the Lord, Alleluia.**

Wednesday 31st May

THE VISITATION OF THE BLESSED VIRGIN MARY

Entrance Antiphon: **Come and hear, all who fear God: I will tell what the Lord did for my soul.**

The **Gloria** is said.

First Reading: Zephaniah 3:14-18
The Lord, the king of Israel, is in your midst.

Alternative First Reading: *Romans 12:9-16*
If any of the saints are in need you must share with them; and you should make hospitality your special care.

Responsorial Psalm: **Great in your midst is the Holy One of Israel.**

Gospel Acclamation: **Alleluia, alleluia! Blessed is the Virgin Mary who believed that the promise made her by the Lord would be fulfilled.**

Gospel: Luke 1:39-56
Why should I be honoured with a visit from the mother of my Lord?

Communion Antiphon: **All generations will call me blessed, for he who is mighty has done great things of me, and holy is his name.**

Thursday 1st June

St Justin, Martyr

Justin was born in Samaria and martyred in the 2nd century. He was a renowned thinker, writer and philosopher.

Entrance Antiphon: **The wicked have told me lies, but not so is your law: I spoke of your decrees before kings, and was not confounded.**

First Reading: Corinthians 1 18-25
God wanted to save those who have faith through the foolishness of the message that we preach.

Responsorial Psalm: **From all my terrors the Lord set me free.**

Gospel Acclamation: **Alleluia, alleluia! Your light must shine in the sight of men, so that, seeing your good works, he may give the praise to your Father in heaven. Alleluia!**

Gospel: Matthew 5:13-19
You are the light of the world.

Communion Antiphon: **I resolved to know nothing while I was with you except Jesus Christ, and him crucified.**

Friday 2nd June

Weekday of Easter or

St Marcellinus and St Peter, Martyrs

Marcellinus was an exorcist and Peter was a priest. They were martyred during the persecution of Diocletian.

Entrance Antiphon: **Christ loved us and washed us clean of our sins by his Blood, and made us into a kingdom, priests for his God and Father, alleluia.**

First Reading: **Acts 25 13-21**
Said to be dying, and here we are alive.

Responsorial Psalm: **Our life, like a bird has escaped from the snare of the fowler.**

Gospel Acclamation: **Alleluia, alleluia! Blessed be God, a gentle Father, and the God of all consolation, who comforts us in all our sorrows. Alleluia.**

Gospel: John 21:15-19
Feed my lambs, feed my sheep.
