Communion Antiphon: **This is the steward, faithful and prudent, whom the Lord set over his household to give them their allowance of food at the proper time.**

Entrance Antiphon: **Your merciful love, O God, we have received in the midst of your temple. Your praise, O God, like your name, reaches the ends of the earth; your right hand is filled with saving justice.**

First Reading: Genesis 41:55-57; 42:5-7. 17-24
Truly we are being called to account for our brother.

Responsorial Psalm: **May your love be upon us, O Lord, as we place all our hope in you.**

Gospel Acclamation: **Alleluia, alleluia! By his own choice the Father made us his children by the message of truth, so that we should be a sort of first-fruits of all that he created. Alleluia!**

Gospel: Matthew 10:1-7
Go to the lost sheep of the house of Israel.

Communion Antiphon: **Taste and see that the Lord is good; blessed the man who seeks refuge in him.**



Weekday or
St Henry, Holy Roman Emperor

Henry II, Duke of Bavaria, was crowned Emperor in 1014. He used his power to extend the kingdom of God by promoting missionary work.

Entrance Antiphon: **Your merciful love, O God, we have received in the midst of your temple. Your praise, O God, like your name, reaches the ends of the earth; your right hand is filled with saving justice.**

First Reading: Genesis 44:18-21. 23-29; 45:1-5
God sent me into Egypt to preserve your lives.

Responsorial Psalm: **Remember the wonders the Lord has done.**

Gospel Acclamation: **Alleluia, alleluia! Harden not your hearts today, but listen to the voice of the Lord. Alleluia!**

Gospel: Matthew 10:7-15
You received without charge, give without charge.

Communion Antiphon: **Taste and see that the Lord is good; blessed the man who seeks refuge in him.**

Friday, 14th July

Weekday or **St Camillus de Lellis, Priest**

Camillus died in 1614. A former soldier and gambler who became ill and experienced the poor standard of health care, later as a priest he founded a congregation of nurses who did much to alleviate the suffering sick.

Entrance Antiphon: **Your merciful love, O God, we have received in the midst of your temple. Your praise, O God, like your name, reaches the ends of the earth; your right hand is filled with saving justice.**

First Reading: Genesis 46:1-7. 28-30
I can die, now that I have seen you.

Responsorial Psalm: **The salvation of the just comes from the Lord.**

Gospel Acclamation: **Alleluia, alleluia! The word of the Lord remains for ever: What is this word? It is the Good News that has been brought to you. Alleluia!**
