WHO ARE WE?

We are those who try to keep God's commandments, those who are happy to follow God's law, even if it sets us apart from the rest of the world. We are the proud possessors of a great wisdom, not a wisdom of this age, but a "hidden wisdom....predestined for our glory ... and revealed to us through the Spirit."
