Finding Fatima

You are invited to watch this documentary that will both move you as well as inspire you on Thursday 23rd November at 7pm in the Fr. Tuite room in Corpus Christi.

The film opens on Hiroshima 1945, where 8 Jesuit priests miraculously survived the atomic bomb without any trace of radiation poisoning and minor injury, when asked why they survived, the only answer they gave was "we survived because we were living the message of Fatima"



In this centenary of the apparitions of Fatima the message of 1917, in a time when a generation of men were being sacrificed on the killing fields of World War I, and the seeds of revolution were being sown in Russia, is as relevant today as it was a hundred years ago. Three young shepherd children made an extraordinary claim, that they had been visited by a lady from heaven who was brighter than the sun and she had a message for mankind.
