Thanks to those who supported the "Day of Prayer for Vocations" on Friday. We continue to pray for those who are studying for the Priesthood and Jason Mahoney who we had with us last year is now, hopefully progressing towards receiving the Order of Candidate on his path to the Priesthood.

Our "Talks on the Faith" will continue on Wednesday, 15th February at 7.00pm and the topic will be the "Eucharist". The following week the Talk is on "Confession". Also this Wednesday, February 15th there is an interesting evening on the "Church and Social Media". This will be in the Library from 7.00pm to 9.00pm. It is a good way of seeing how we can use modern means of communication in relation to our faith. Because of this talk in the Library, the "Talks on the Faith" will be in the meeting room. The Talks on the Faith will end before Easter allowing people to be received into the Church at the Easter Vigil. The Deanery is organising Talks on Prayer beginning after Easter. We are hosting these talks. There is an Introduction Evening on Sunday, 23rd April at 6.30pm in the Library, followed by a series of five talks on Thursday evenings at the end of April and through May. Prayer is an essential part of our life as Catholics which we often neglect. Please consider supporting these talks. Someone will come and talk about the course at the end of the month.

There is a new white book case on the side aisle of the Church which contains some books and resources which you can use with the children during Mass. Please return the resources to the book case at the end of Mass.

Next weekend, we will be starting to recruit volunteers for the "Good Neighbours" Scheme. It will be a chance to work in Coundon and Radford along with members of other Churches. The scheme will visit people who are often on their own and will just require volunteers to give up an hour every few weeks to visit or to even make a regular phone call.
