Dear Parishioners

This weekend is Remembrance Sunday and we will be joining in prayer with people around the world, remembering those who have died as a result of warfare. We remember all casualties of war, especially those who continue to live with their injuries, both physical and mental and their loved ones who share their burden. Coventry is a city of peace and reconciliation and is also remembered for the destruction of warfare. As residents of the city, we can pray for peace in a very special way. Some of our parishioners will have their own memories of the cost of war. The children will help with our services of remembrance, we will also be presenting children with rosaries beads this weekend as part of their preparation of their Holy Communion and the theme of Prayer. We will honour the fallen with a minute's silence at each of the Masses over the weekend.

This Tuesday, 14th November, we have a Mass for the Deceased Clergy of the Coventry Deanery. This will be at Sacred Heart Church at 7.00pm followed by a buffet. I will be celebrating the Mass with the other Priests and Deacons of the Deanery and we will read out the names of the Deceased Clergy. Please try and come along and support this event.

We will be using our Book of Remembrance at each of the Masses in November, praying for the Holy Souls. Please let us have your names for the Holy Souls list and place the envelopes in the box at the back of the Church or through the Presbytery letter box. We will end the month with a Mass for all those who have died in the past year. Families will have received letters inviting them to come to this Mass on Saturday 25th November at the 6.00pm Mass. We will read out the names of those who have died during the year and light candles in their memory.

Next year our Parish Pilgrimage will be to Fatima. We will visit Fatima for five days from Saturday June 2nd to Wednesday June 6th. We will fly from Heathrow with British Airways and the cost includes all coach transfers and travel, airfare and four nights full board at the hotel in Fatima. The price will be £500. Could you please contact Fiona at the Parish Office if you are interested in coming. There has been a big demand for places, so we are hoping to increase the places available to fifty.
