ASSOCIATE MEMBERSHIP OF THE ORDINARIATE The Ordinariate has launched a new initiative which enables Catholics who are not members of the Ordinariate nevertheless to identify more closely with the life and mission of the ordinariate, by way of support, both in prayer and in other ways. ADOREMUS A National Eucharistic Pilgrimage and Congress (Adoremus) will take place in Liverpool 7-9 September 2018.
