CHRISM MASS This year's Chrism Mass for the ordinariate takes place at 11.30am on Monday of Holy Week, 10th April, at Our Lady of the Assumption & St Gregory, Warwick Street, London. Bishop Robert will be the principal celebrant. Concelebrating priests will be wearing the new ordinariate chasuble - bearing symbols both of Our Lady of Walsingham and Blessed John Henry Newman - for the first time.
