**"He will lease the vineyard to other tenants ... I tell you , then, that the kingdom of God will be taken from you and given to a people that will produce its fruit."
(Mt. 21:41.43).**

Dear parishioners, in today's gospel, Jesus uses a remarkable parable to show the chief priest and the elders of Israel about the contrast between God's love and the cruelty of the unfaithful tenants. Indeed, God cared for his people as a good gardener cares for his vineyard; however they failed to produce the desired fruits. We are the new people of God, the vineyard planted and cared for by Christ. God calls us to give up our sinful way, return to him and produce fruits of holiness, justice and peace that he expects. Sadly, like the leaders of the Jews, we often follow our own way rather than God's way. As members of the Church here in Tile Hill, God's new tenants, if God would collect his produce from us, what would we contribute or repay?
