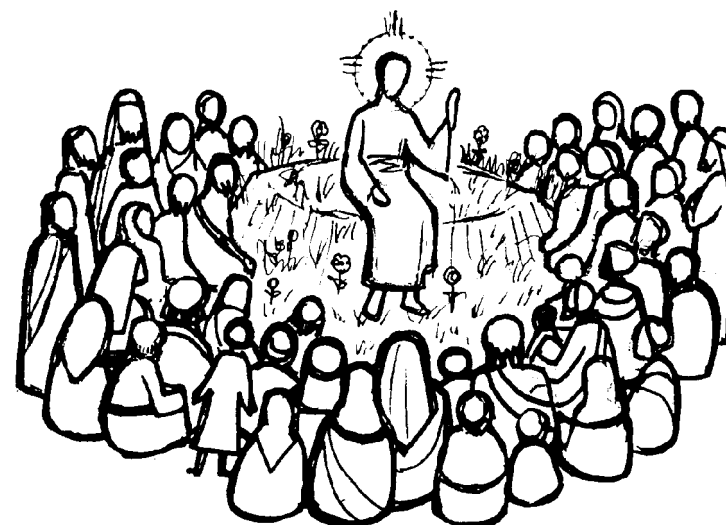

Preface 5 of Sundays in Ordinary Time - Eucharistic Prayer II.

Sunday 12th February 2017



**"You have learnt how it was said to our ancestors ... but I say this to you."
(Mt.5:27-28).**

Dear Parishioners, in the Old Testament, in order to help people to follow God's way, through Moses, God sent them the law. However during the history of salvation, God's people often kept God's law by its letter rather than by its spirit. Therefore when Jesus came down on earth, he guided us to understand the spirit of the law as we have just heard in today's gospel. He showed us the positive aspect of the law rather than the negative one. For example: the law said: "You must not kill, if anyone does kill he must answer for it before the court." Meanwhile Jesus says: "Anyone who is angry with his brother, will answer for it before the court." Therefore in order to fulfil God's law positively, we cannot say that if we do not commit murder, it means we have fulfilled the law. We need to show our love and care for others. If we are angry with someone else, it means we lack love. We are all called to holiness and to share God's life. We need to follow God's way by loving one another because God is love. Anger will become an obstacle for us on the way to holiness. Lord Jesus, you come to show us God's way and guide us to the Father's house. Without you we can do nothing. Give us the ability to love and to forgive others indifferent to us so that we may be worthy of your loving witness in today's world.
