HOLY WEEK begins next Sunday. The schedule for Holy Week – and particularly the Paschal Triduum – will be available next Sunday. The principal liturgies to note are:

Good Friday	Solemn Liturgy of the Lord's Passion,	3.00pm
Holy Saturday	Easter Vigil	8.30pm
Easter Sunday	Solemn Mass	11.00am

PALM SUNDAY Please make sure that you begin Holy Week by being at Mass next Sunday. Weather permitting, we gather in the far car park for Mass for the blessing of palms and procession, otherwise in the hall.

CHRISM MASS This year's Chrism Mass for the ordinariate takes place at 11.30am on Monday of Holy Week, 10th April, at Our Lady of the Assumption & St Gregory, Warwick Street, London. Bishop Robert Byrne will be the principal celebrant.

Its language and many of the prayers included give expression to those aspects of the Anglican tradition which have been welcomed into the Catholic Church through the establishment of the ordinariate.
