Parish Mass Book - Readings on page 62

Lord, if it is you, tell me to come to you across the water.

In today's extract from the Book of Kings we are introduced to two of the themes that run through today's readings: Silence, and the unexpected. Elijah was weary after his conflicts with the prophets of Baal. It is said that, he heard the storm, fire and the earthquake which Moses heard (Ex 19:14-19)., but this time, God passed in a gentle breeze. This passing by of God, prepares us for Jesus walking on the sea, and calming his disciples who were so frightened.

God speaks to us in events. He is in our laughter and in our fear. God is with us in the ordinary, and in the unexpected storms. God knows that we start things and do not always continue and cannot always find the faith, let alone the courage to walk towards Him. We imagine that God will override the noise of our world to tell us what He wants us to do. But God is unexpectedly silent. Yet if we find in the day a time to be silent with God, then His voice will be in that stillness and his hands will hold us, assuring and encouraging us not to be afraid.
