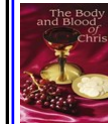

Meeting Jesus in the Eucharist

The focus of the readings is on the body and blood of Christ found in the Holy Eucharist. In the first reading, Moses speaks of feeding on Manna from heaven unknown to all. In the second reading, St. Paul emphasizes on the sharing of one loaf that makes us form a single body united in Christ.

We all want to meet Jesus. We want to have a closer friendship with Jesus. We want to have more of Jesus in our lives. We have to come to the right place, to the Eucharist. The best place to meet Jesus is in the Eucharist. If we want to be intimate with Jesus he tells us how, whoever eats my flesh and drinks my blood remains in me and I in him. (John 6:56)

Our most intimate moment with Jesus is when we receive Jesus in Holy Communion. We receive Jesus into our very bodies. We become what we eat. We are not only closer to Jesus but we are one with Jesus.

Just as we read in Genesis about man and woman becoming one in marriage; when we receive Jesus in Holy Communion we are no longer two but one and we and Jesus are intimately united.

Jesus gave himself for us on Calvary and gives himself for us again in Holy Communion. In today's Gospel we heard Jesus say, the bread that I will give is my flesh for the life of the world. (John 6:51). Let us constantly seek to become true witnesses of Jesus in our lives.
