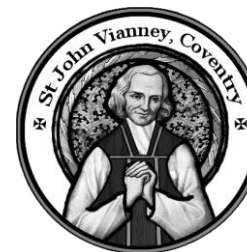

Dear Parishioners of St. John Vianney,

On **Tuesday** we celebrate the **Solemnity of the Assumption of Our Blessed Lady into Heaven**. It is a **Holy Day of Obligation** when we are expected to go to Mass. Masses will be celebrated here at **9am and 7.30pm**. The feast day celebrates the significant role of Our Lady in the story of salvation. She had been saved from the very first moment of her life and became the worthy dwelling place for the Son of God. At the end of her life she was taken body and soul into the glory of heaven. On this feast day we remember that we are to be united with the Lord and with Our Lady and All of the Saint in the joy of heaven. We seek her intercession on this great feast day.

LIFE IN THE SPIRIT GROUP: Following on from the Coventry Deanery "The Gift" course, a "Life in the Spirit Group" has been established that will support on-going spiritual formation for parishioners. We will share in this work with the people of St. Joseph's Parish. The idea of the group is to help people grow in faith through the gift of prayer as well as through experiencing and praying alongside other people.
