Fourth Week of Lent

Monday, 27<sup>th</sup> March

Gospel Acclamation: **Praise and honour to you, Lord Jesus! I take pleasure, not in the death of the wicked man - it is the Lord who speaks – but in the turning back of a wicked man who changes his ways to win life. Praise and honour to you Lord Jesus!**

Gospel: **John 7:40-52**

Do not pass judgement.

Communion Antiphon: **By the precious Blood of Christ, the Blood of a spotless and unblemished Lamb, we have been redeemed.**

Entrance Antiphon: **As for me, I trust in the Lord. Let me be glad and rejoice in your mercy, for you have seen my affliction.**

First Reading: Isaiah 65:17-21

*Be glad and rejoice forever.*

Responsorial Psalm: **I will praise you, Lord you have rescued me.**

Gospel Acclamation: **Praise and honour to you Lord Jesus! My soul is waiting for the Lord, I count on his word, because with the Lord is mercy and fullness of redemption. Praise and honour to you, Lord Jesus!**

Gospel: John 4:43-54

*The second sign given by Jesus.*

Communion Antiphon: **I will place my spirit within you and make you walk according to my laws; and my judgements you shall keep and observe, says the Lord.**

Wednesday, 28<sup>th</sup> March

Weekday of Lent


Entrance Antiphon: **All who are thirsty, come to the waters, says the Lord. Though you have no money, come and drink with joy.**

First Reading: Ezekiel 47:1-9. 12

*This water comes from the sanctuary.*

Responsorial Psalm: **The Lord of hosts is with us: the God of Jacob is our stronghold.**

Gospel Acclamation: **Praise and honour to you, Lord Jesus! A pure heart create for me, O God, and give me again the joy of your help. Praise and honour to you, Lord Jesus!**

Communion Antiphon: **The Lord is my shepherd; there is nothing I shall want. Fresh and green are the pastures where he gives me repose, near restful waters he leads me.**

**Wednesday, 29<sup>th</sup> March**

**Weekday of Lent**

Entrance Antiphon: **I pray to you, O Lord, for a time of your favour. In your great mercy, answer me, O God, with your salvation that never fails.**

First Reading: Isaiah 49: 8-15

*The Lord consoles his people.*

Responsorial Psalm: **The Lord is kind and full of compassion.**

Gospel Acclamation: **Glory and praise to you, O Christ! God loved the world so much that he gave his only Son: everyone who believes in him has eternal life. Glory and praise to you, O Christ!**

Gospel: John 5:17-30

*Your father Abraham rejoiced to think that he would see my Day.*

Communion Antiphon: **God did not send his Son into the world to judge the world, but that the world might be saved through him.**

**Thursday, 30<sup>th</sup> March**

**Weekday of Lent**

Entrance Antiphon: **Let the hearts that seek the Lord rejoice; turn to the Lord and his strength; constantly seek his face.**

First Reading: Exodus 32:7-14

*Moses pleads for the people.*

Responsorial Psalm: **O Lord, remember me out of the love you have for your people.**

Gospel Acclamation: **Glory to you, O Christ, you are the Word of God! Your words are spirit, Lord, and they are life; you have the message of eternal life. Glory to you, O Christ! You are the word of God!**

Gospel: John 5:31-47

*Believe that the Father has sent me.*

Communion Antiphon: **I will place my law within them, and I will write it upon their hearts; and I will be their God, and they will be my people, says the Lord.**

**Friday, 31<sup>st</sup> March**

**Weekday of Lent**

Entrance Antiphon: **O God, save me by your name; by your power, defend my cause. O God, hear my prayer; give ear to the words of my mouth.**

First Reading: Wisdom 2:1 12-22

*Holiness will be rewarded.*

Responsorial Psalm: **The Lord is close to the broken-hearted.**

Gospel Acclamation: **Praise to you, O Christ, king of eternal glory! Now, now – it is the Lord who speaks – come back to me with all your heart, for I am all tenderness and compassion. Praise to you, O Christ, king of eternal glory!**

Gospel: John 7:1-2 10.25-30

*No-one laid a hand on him.*

Communion Antiphon: **In Christ, we have redemption by his Blood, and forgiveness of our sins, in accord with the riches of his grace.**

**Saturday, 1<sup>st</sup> April**

**Weekday of Lent**

Entrance Antiphon: **The waves of death rose about me; the pains of the netherworld surrounded me. In my anguish I called to the Lord, and from his holy temple he heard my voice.**

First Reading: Jeremiah 11:18-20

*I have committed my cause to you.*

Responsorial Psalm: **Lord God, I take refuge in you.**
