Responsorial Psalm: **I will thank you, Lord, for you have given answer.**

Gospel Acclamation: **Alleluia, alleluia! This day was made by the Lord; we rejoice and are glad. Alleluia!**

Gospel: Mark 16:9-15

Go out to the whole world: proclaim the Good News.

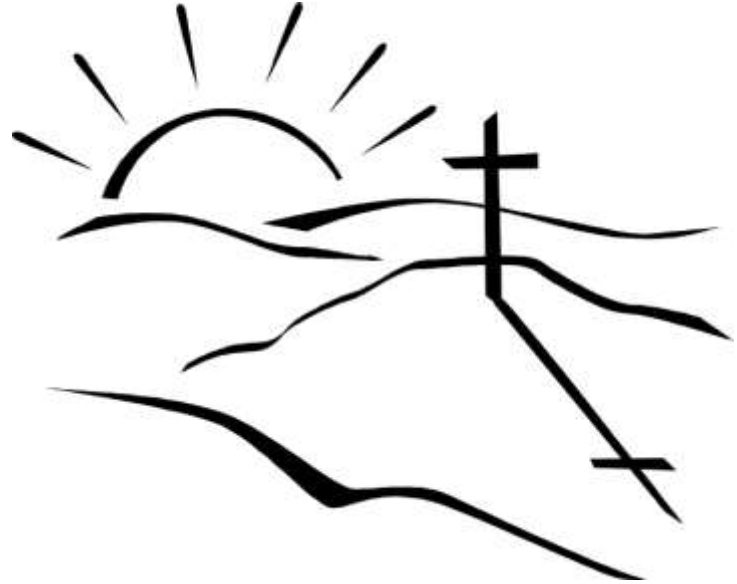
Communion Antiphon: **All of you who have been baptised in Christ have put on Christ, alleluia.**

Monday, 2nd April

EASTER MONDAY

Entrance Antiphon: **The Lord has led you into a land flowing with milk and honey, that the law of the Lord may always be on your lips, alleluia.**

The **Gloria** is said.

First Reading: Acts 2:14. 22-33

God raised this man Jesus to life, and all of us are witnesses to that.

Responsorial Psalm: **Preserve me, Lord, I take refuge in you.**

Gospel Acclamation: **Alleluia, alleluia! This day was made by the Lord; we rejoice and are glad. Alleluia!**

Gospel: Matthew 28:8-15

Tell my brothers that they must leave for Galilee; they will see me there.

Communion Antiphon: **Christ, having risen from the dead, dies now no more; death will no longer have dominion over him, alleluia.**

Tuesday, 3rd April

EASTER TUESDAY

Entrance Antiphon: **He gave them the water of wisdom to drink; it will be made strong in them and will not be moved; it will raise them up for ever, alleluia.**

The **Gloria** is said.

First Reading: Acts 2:36-41

You must repent and every one of you must be baptised in the name of Jesus.

Responsorial Psalm: **The Lord fills the earth with his love.**

Gospel Acclamation: **Alleluia, alleluia! This day was made by the Lord; we rejoice and are glad. Alleluia!**

Gospel: John 20:11-18

I have seen the Lord and he has spoken to me.

Communion Antiphon: **If you have risen with Christ, seek the things that are above, where Christ is seated at the right hand of God; mind the things that are above, alleluia.**

Wednesday, 4th April

EASTER WEDNESDAY

Entrance Antiphon: **Come, you blessed of my Father; receive the kingdom prepared for you from the foundation of the world, alleluia.**

The **Gloria** is said.

First Reading: Acts 3:1-10

I will give you what I have: in the name of Jesus stand up and walk.

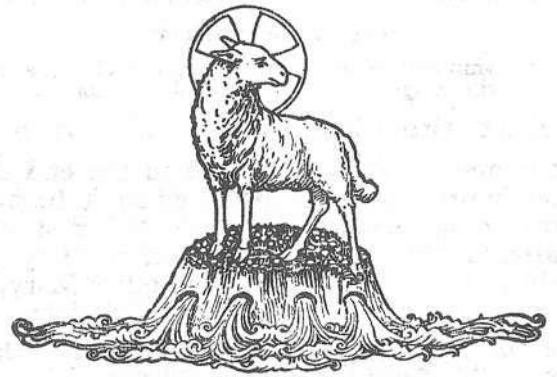
Responsorial Psalm: **Let the hearts that seek the Lord rejoice.**

Gospel Acclamation: **Alleluia, alleluia! This day was made by the Lord; we rejoice and are glad. Alleluia!**

Gospel: Luke 24:13-35

They recognised Jesus at the breaking of the bread.

Communion Antiphon: **The disciples recognised the Lord Jesus in the breaking of the bread, alleluia.**



Thursday, 5th April

EASTER THURSDAY

Entrance Antiphon: **They praised in unison your conquering hand, O Lord, for wisdom opened mouths that were mute and gave eloquence to the tongues of infants, alleluia.**

The **Gloria** is said.

First Reading: Acts 3:11-26

You killed the prince of life. God, however, raised him from the dead.

Responsorial Psalm: **How great is your name, O Lord our God, through all the earth.**

Gospel Acclamation: **Alleluia, alleluia! This day was made by the Lord; we rejoice and are glad. Alleluia!**

Gospel: Luke 24:35-48

It is written that the Christ would suffer and on the third day rise from the dead.

Communion Antiphon: **O chosen people, proclaim the mighty works of him, who called you out of darkness into his wonderful light, alleluia.**

Friday, 6th April

EASTER FRIDAY

Entrance Antiphon: **The Lord led his people in hope, while the sea engulfed their foes, alleluia.**

The **Gloria** is said.

First Reading: Acts 4:1-12

This is the only name by which we can be saved.
