Entrance Antiphon: **O chosen people, proclaim the mighty works of him who called you out of darkness into his wonderful light, alleluia.**

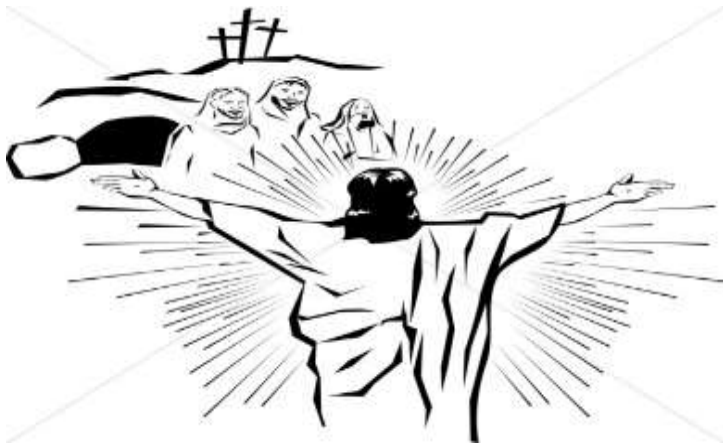
First Reading: Acts 6:1-7

Responsorial Psalm: **May your love be upon us, O Lord, as we place all our hope in you.**

Gospel Acclamation: **Alleluia, alleluia! Christ, having been raised from the dead, will never die again. Death has no power over him any more. Alleluia!**

Gospel: John 6:16-21
They saw Jesus walking on the lake.

Communion Antiphon: **Father, I wish that, where I am, those you gave me may also be with me, that they may see the glory that you gave me, alleluia.**

Monday, 9th April

THE ANNUNCIATION OF THE LORD



Entrance Antiphon: **The Lord said, as he entered the world: Behold, I come to do your will, O God.**

The **Gloria** is said.

First Reading: Isaiah 7:10-14. 8:10
The maiden is with child.

Responsorial Psalm: **Here I am, Lord! I come to do your will.**

Second Reading: Hebrews 10:4-10
I was commanded in the scroll of the book, 'God, here I am! I am coming to obey your will.'

Gospel Acclamation: **Alleluia, alleluia! The Word was made flesh, he lived among us, and we saw his glory. Alleluia, alleluia!**

Gospel: Luke 1:26-38
You are to conceive and bear a son.

The **Creed** is said. At the words 'and was incarnate' all **genuflect**.

Communion Antiphon: **Behold, a Virgin shall conceive and bear a son; and his name will be called Emmanuel.**

Tuesday, 10th April

Weekday of Easter

Entrance Antiphon: **Let us rejoice and be glad and give glory to God, for the Lord our God the Almighty reigns, alleluia.**

First Reading: Acts 4:32-27

United, heart and soul.

Responsorial Psalm: **The Lord is king, with majesty enrobed.**

Gospel Acclamation: **Alleluia, alleluia! You, O Christ, are the faithful witness, the First-born from the dead; you have loved us and have washed away our sins with your blood. Alleluia!**

Gospel: John 3:7-15

No one has gone up to heaven except the one who came down from heaven, the Son of Man.

Communion Antiphon: **The Christ had to suffer and rise from the dead, and so enter into his glory, alleluia.**

Wednesday, 11th April

Weekday in Easter

St Stanislaus, Bishop & Martyr

Stanislaus was born in Poland around 1030. In 1071 he became Bishop of Krakow. He rebuked the King and was martyred whilst celebrating Mass in 1079.

Entrance Antiphon: **Perpetual light will shine on your Saints, O Lord, and life without end for ever, alleluia.**

First Reading: Acts 5:17-26

The men you imprisoned are in the Temple, preaching to the people.

Responsorial Psalm: **This poor man called and the Lord heard him.**

Gospel Acclamation: **Alleluia, alleluia! Christ has risen and shone upon us whom he redeemed with his blood. Alleluia!**

Gospel: John 3:16-21

God sent his Son into the world so that through him the world might be saved.

Communion Antiphon: **Unless a grain of wheat falls into the ground and dies, it remains just a grain of wheat; but if it dies, it produces much fruit, alleluia.**

Thursday, 12th April

Weekday in Easter

Entrance Antiphon: **O God, when you went forth before your people, marching with them and living among them, the earth trembled, heavens poured down rain, alleluia.**

First Reading: Acts 5:27-33

We are witnesses to all this, we and the Holy Spirit.

Responsorial Psalm: **This poor man called and the Lord heard him.**

Gospel Acclamation: **Alleluia, alleluia! Christ has risen: he who created all things, and has granted his mercy to men. Alleluia!**

Gospel: John 3:31-36

The Father loves the Son and has entrusted everything to him.

Communion Antiphon: **Behold, I am with you always, even to the end of the age, alleluia.**

Friday, 13th April

Weekday of Easter

St Martin I, Pope & Martyr

Martin was born in Umbria, Italy. He was elected Pope in 649 and defended the Church against Heresy. He was sent into exile by the Emperor and was condemned to death and died a martyr in 651.

Entrance Antiphon: **You have redeemed us, Lord, by your Blood, from every tribe and tongue and people and nation, and have made us into a kingdom, priests for our God, alleluia.**

First Reading: Acts 5:34-42

The left, glad to have had the honour of suffering humiliation for the sake of the name of Jesus.
