Weekday in Easter

St Anselm, Bishop, Doctor of the Church

Anselm was born in Aosta and died in England. He was a Benedictine monk who became Archbishop of Canterbury. He is called the Father of Scholastic Theology and his works are amongst the best examples of theology and medieval mysticism

Entrance Antiphon: You have been buried with Christ in Baptism, through which you also rose again by faith in the working of God, who raised him from the dead, alleluia.

First Reading: Acts 9:31-42

The churches built themselves up and were filled with the consolation of the Holy Spirit.

Responsorial Psalm: How can I repay the Lord for his goodness to me?

Gospel Acclamation: Alleluia, alleluia! We know that Christ is truly risen from the dead; have mercy on us, triumphant King. Alleluia!

Gospel: John 6:60-69

Who shall we go to? You have the message of eternal life.

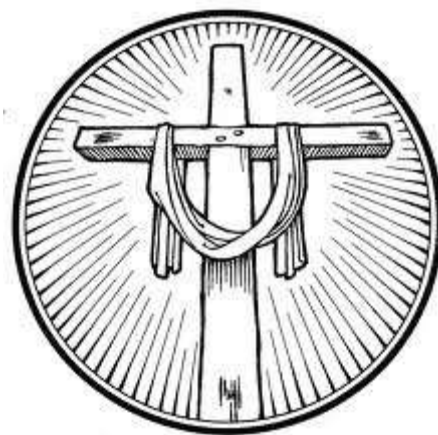
Communion Antiphon: Father, I pray for them, that they may be one in us, so that the world may believe it was you who sent me, says the Lord, alleluia.

Monday, 16th April

Weekday in Easter

Entrance Antiphon: The Good Shepherd has risen, who laid down his life for his sheep and willingly died for his flock, alleluia.

First Reading: Acts 6:8-15

They could not get the better of Stephen because of his wisdom, and because it was the Spirit that promoted what he said.

Responsorial Psalm: They are happy whose life is blameless.

Gospel Acclamation: Alleluia, alleluia! You believe, Thomas, because you can see me. Happy are those who have not seen and yet believe. Alleluia, alleluia!

Gospel: John 6:22-29

Do not work for food that cannot last, but work for food that endures to eternal life.

Communion Antiphon: Peace I leave with you; my peace I give to you. Not as the world gives do I give it to you, says the Lord, alleluia.

Tuesday, 17th April

Weekday of Easter

Entrance Antiphon: **Sing praise to our God, all you who fear God, both small and great, for now salvation and strength have come, and the power of his Christ, alleluia.**

First Reading: Acts 7:51 – 8:1

Lord Jesus, receive my spirit.

Responsorial Psalm: **Into your hands, O Lord, I commend my spirit.**

Gospel Acclamation: **Alleluia, alleluia! I am the good shepherd, says the Lord, I know my sheep and my own know me. Alleluia!**

Gospel: John 6:30-35

It was not Moses who gave you bread from heaven, it is my Father who gives you the bread from heaven, the true bread.

Communion Antiphon: **If we have died with Christ, we believe that we shall also live with Christ, alleluia.**

Wednesday, 18th April

Weekday in Easter

Entrance Antiphon: **Let my mouth be filled with your praise, that I may sing aloud; my lips shall shout for joy, when I sing to you, alleluia.**

First Reading: Acts 8:1-8

They went from place to place preaching the Good News.

Responsorial Psalm: **Cry out with joy to God all the earth.**

Gospel Acclamation: **Alleluia, alleluia! The sheep that belong to me listen to my voice, says the Lord; I know them and they follow me. Alleluia!**

Gospel: John 6:35-40

It is my Father's will that whoever sees the Son shall have eternal life.

Communion Antiphon: **The Lord has risen and shone his light upon us, whom he has redeemed by his Blood, alleluia.**

Thursday, 19th April

Weekday in Easter

Entrance Antiphon: **Let us sing to the Lord, for he has gloriously triumphed. The Lord is my strength and my might; he has become my salvation, alleluia.**

First Reading: Acts 8:26-40

If you believe with all your heart, you may be baptised.

Responsorial Psalm: **Cry out with joy to God all the earth.**

Gospel Acclamation: **Alleluia, alleluia! The Lord, who hung for us upon the tree, has risen from the tomb. Alleluia!**

Gospel: John 6:44-51

I am the living bread which has come down from heaven.

Communion Antiphon: **Christ died for all, that those who live may live no longer for themselves, but for him, who died for them and is risen, alleluia.**

Friday, 20th April

Weekday of Easter

Entrance Antiphon: **Worthy is the Lamb who was slain, to receive power and divinity, and wisdom and strength and honour, alleluia.**

First Reading: Acts 9:1-20

This man is my chosen instrument to bring my name before pagans.

Responsorial Psalm: **Go out to the whole world; proclaim the Good News.**

Gospel Acclamation: **Alleluia, alleluia! It was ordained that Christ should suffer and rise from the dead, and so enter into his glory. Alleluia!**

Gospel: John 6:52-59

My flesh is real food and my blood is real drink.

Communion Antiphon: **The Crucified is risen from the dead and has redeemed us, alleluia.**
