

Saturday 19<sup>th</sup> May

Weekday in Easter or  
St Dunstan, Bishop

*Dunstan died in 988, a Benedictine monk who was appointed Archbishop of Canterbury. He was a confidante of Kings and did much to restore Benedictine monasticism.*

Entrance Antiphon: **The disciples devoted themselves with one accord to prayer with the women, and Mary the Mother of Jesus, and his brethren, alleluia.**

First Reading: Acts 28:16-20. 30-31  
*Paul stayed in Rome, proclaiming the kingdom of God.*

Responsorial Psalm: **The upright shall see your face, O Lord.**

Gospel Acclamation: **Alleluia, alleluia! Since you have been brought back to true life with Christ, you must look for the things that are in heaven where Christ is sitting at God's right hand. Alleluia!**

Gospel: John 21:20-25  
*This disciple is the one who has written these things down, and we know that his testimony is true.*

Communion Antiphon: **The Holy Spirit will glorify me, for he will take from what is mine and declare it to you, says the Lord, alleluia.**

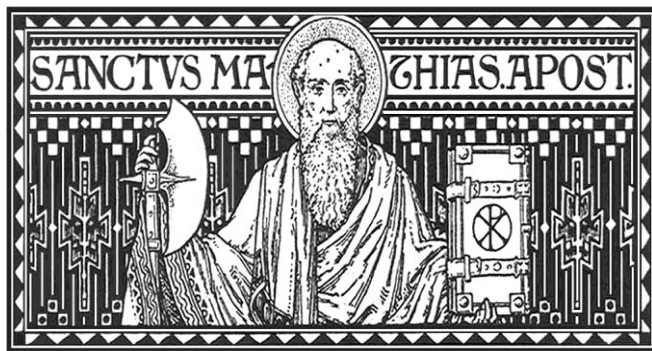
# WEEKDAY MASS SHEET

Monday, 14<sup>th</sup> May

ST MATTHIAS, APOSTLE



*Matthias was chosen by the Apostles to take the place of Judas Iscariot, so that the number of apostles might remain as twelve. Tradition has it that Matthias went on to preach in Ethiopia.*

Entrance Antiphon: **It was not you who chose me, says the Lord, but I who chose you and appointed you to go and bear fruit, fruit that will last, alleluia.**

The **Gloria** is said.

First Reading: Acts 1:15-17. 20-26  
*The lot fell to Matthias and he was listed as one of the twelve apostles.*

Responsorial Psalm: **The Lord sets him in the company of the princes of his people.**

Gospel Acclamation: **Alleluia, alleluia! I chose you from the world to go out and to bear fruit, fruit that will last, says the Lord. Alleluia!**

Gospel: John 15:9-17  
*You did not choose me, no, I chose you.*

Communion Antiphon: **This is my commandment: Love one another as I love you, says the Lord, alleluia.**

**Tuesday, 15<sup>th</sup> May**

**Weekday in Easter**

Entrance Antiphon: **I am the first and the last. I was dead and am now alive. Behold, I am alive for ever and ever, alleluia.**

First Reading: Acts 20:17-27

*I am finishing my race and carrying out the mission the Lord Jesus gave me.*

Responsorial Psalm: **Kingdoms of the earth, sing to God.**

Gospel Acclamation: **Alleluia, alleluia! I will not leave you orphans, says the Lord; I go, but I will come back to you, and your hearts will be full of joy. Alleluia!**

Gospel: John 17:1-11

*Father, glorify your Son.*

Communion Antiphon: **The Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in my name, will teach you all things and remind you of all I have told you, says the Lord, alleluia.**

**Wednesday, 16<sup>th</sup> May**

**Weekday in Easter**

Entrance Antiphon: **All peoples, clap your hands. Cry to God with shouts of joy, alleluia.**

First Reading: Acts 20:28-38

*I commend you to God, who has power to build you up and to give you your inheritance.*

Responsorial Psalm: **Kingdoms of the earth, sing to God.**

Gospel Acclamation: **Alleluia, alleluia! Go make disciples of all nations: I am with you always; yes, to the end of time. Alleluia!**

Gospel: John 17:11-19

*May they be one like us.*

Communion Antiphon: **When the Paraclete comes, whom I will send you, the Spirit of Truth who proceeds from the Father, he will bear witness to me, and you also bear witness, says the Lord, alleluia.**

**Thursday, 17<sup>th</sup> May**

**Weekday in Easter**

Entrance Antiphon: **With boldness let us approach the throne of grace, they we may receive mercy and find grace as a timely help, alleluia.**

First Reading: Acts 22:30; 23:6-11

*Now you must bear witness in Rome.*

Responsorial Psalm: **Preserve me, Lord, I take refuge in you.**

Gospel Acclamation: **Alleluia, alleluia! I will send you the Spirit of truth, says the Lord; he will lead you to the complete truth. Alleluia!**

Gospel: John 17:20-26

*May they be completely one.*

Communion Antiphon: **I tell you the truth, it is for your good that I go; for if I do not go away, the Paraclete will not come to you, says the Lord, alleluia.**

**Friday, 18<sup>th</sup> May**

**Weekday in Easter or**

**St John I, Pope and Martyr**

*A short pontificate of three years, John tried to reconcile the Eastern Emperor and the Gothic King. He died in 526.*

Entrance Antiphon: **Christ loved us and washed us clean of our sins by his Blood, and made us into a kingdom, priests for his God and Father, alleluia.**

First Reading: Acts 25:13-21

*A dead man called Jesus whom Paul alleged to be alive.*

Responsorial Psalm: **The Lord has set his sway in heaven.**

Gospel Acclamation: **Alleluia, alleluia! The Holy Spirit will teach you everything and remind you of all I have said to you. Alleluia!**

Gospel: John 21:15-19

*Feed my lambs, feed my sheep.*

Communion Antiphon: **When the Spirit of truth comes, he will teach you all truth, says the Lord, alleluia.**
