SCRIPTURE NOTES

Paul here is rounding off the discussion of what to do about food offered to false gods in pagan worship. He sees that it is possible for Christians to rise above the old ways, with which they are nevertheless surrounded in their daily lives. We might say that he is in the process of working out what it means to live, as a Christian, in a multicultural and religiously plural society. "Do nothing offensive to anyone – to Jews or Greeks or the Church of God". The salvation of all people, which had been his vocation, was turning out to be more complicated than it had first seemed.
