Ash Wednesday - A day of Fasting and Abstinence

Just a reminder that Ash Wednesday is a day of Fasting and Abstinence.

The days that we are asked to fast and abstain help us not only prepare ourselves for up coming Liturgical Feasts but they also help us acquire mastery over our instincts and freedom of heart.

Every Friday in the year, unless a Solemnity, is a day of Abstinence.

Each Friday we recall the memory of the death of the Lord. By denying ourselves something like meat, or something else if a person is vegetarian we unite ourselves to the Lord's death and it helps us prepare for Mass on the weekend when we gather to celebrate the Lord's day, the day of the Resurrection.

The Precepts of the Church, like fasting and abstinence gladden the heart, they guarantee to the faithful the indispensable minimum in the spirit of prayer and moral effort, in the growth in love of God and neighbour.
