**St. Richard of Chichester,  
Bishop**

*Richard was born in Droitwich, Worcestershire c.1197 and was appointed Bishop of Chichester in 1244 against the wishes of the monarch, Henry III. He was both hardworking and charitable. He is said to have dropped the chalice while celebrating Mass which miraculously remained unspilled. In art he is often depicted with a chalice at his feet.*

*I say to you do not swear at all.*


Communion Antiphon: **The Lord is my rock, my fortress, and my deliverer; my God is my saving strength.**

**Monday, 11<sup>th</sup> June**

**St Barnabas, Apostle**

*Barnabas was a Jew who came from Cyprus and became one of the first converts in Jerusalem. He introduced Paul to the Apostles and worked with him on his missions. His death is unrecorded but his remains were discovered on this day in the 5th century.*

Entrance Antiphon: **Blessed is this holy man, who was worthy to be numbered among the Apostles, for he was a good man, filled with the Holy Spirit and with faith.**

First Reading: Acts 11:21-26; 13:1-3  
*He was a good man, filled with the Holy Spirit and with faith.*

Responsorial Psalm: **The Lord has shown his salvation to the nations.**

Gospel Acclamation: **Alleluia, alleluia! Go, make disciples of all the nations, says the Lord; I am with you always, yes, to the end of time. Alleluia!**

Gospel: Matthew 10:7-13  
*You received without charge, give without charge.*

Communion Antiphon: **I no longer call you slaves, because a slave does not know what his master is doing. But I have called you friends, because I have told you everything I have heard from my Father.**

Tuesday, 12<sup>th</sup> June

Weekday

Entrance Antiphon: **The Lord is my light and my salvation; whom shall I fear? The Lord is the stronghold of my life; whom should I dread? When those who do evil draw near, they stumble and fall.**

First Reading: 1 Kings 17:7-16

*The jar of meal was not spent, just as the Lord had foretold through Elijah.*

Responsorial Psalm: **Lift up the light of your face on us, O Lord.**

Gospel Acclamation: **Alleluia, alleluia! You will shine in the world like bright stars because you are offering it the word of life. Alleluia!**

Gospel: Matthew 5:13-16

*You are the light of the world.*

Communion Antiphon: **The Lord is my rock, my fortress, and my deliverer; my God is my saving strength.**

Wednesday, 13<sup>th</sup> June

**St Anthony of Padua, Priest  
and Doctor of the Church**

*Anthony was born in Lisbon in 1195 and died in Padua in 1231. He became a Franciscan and is remembered and loved as an inspired preacher, a servant of the poor and a worker of miracles.*

Entrance Antiphon: **The Lord chose him for himself as high priest, and, opening his treasure house, made him rich in all good things.**

First Reading: 1 Kings 18:20-39

*May this people know that you, Lord, are God and are winning back their hearts.*

Responsorial Psalm: **Save me, Lord, I take refuge in you.**

Gospel Acclamation: **Alleluia, alleluia! Make me grasp the way of your precepts, and I will muse on your wonders. Alleluia!**

Gospel: Matthew 5:17-19

*I have come not to abolish the Law of the Prophets but to complete them.*

Communion Antiphon: **The good shepherd has laid down his life for his sheep.**

Thursday, 14<sup>th</sup> June

Weekday

Entrance Antiphon: **The Lord is my light and my salvation; whom shall I fear? The Lord is the stronghold of my life; whom should I dread? When those who do evil draw near, they stumble and fall.**

First Reading: 1 Kings 18:41-46

*Elijah prayed and the sky gave rain.*

Responsorial Psalm: **To you our praise is due in Zion, O God.**

Gospel Acclamation: **Alleluia, alleluia! Accept God's message for what it really is: God's message, and not some human thinking. Alleluia!**

Gospel: Matthew 5:20-26

*Anyone who is angry with his brother will answer for it before the court.*

Communion Antiphon: **The Lord is my rock, my fortress, and my deliverer; my God is my saving strength.**

Friday, 15<sup>th</sup> June

Weekday

Entrance Antiphon: **The Lord is my light and my salvation; whom shall I fear? The Lord is the stronghold of my life; whom should I dread? When those who do evil draw near, they stumble and fall.**

First Reading: 1 Kings 19:9. 11-16

*Stand on the mountain before the Lord God.*

Responsorial Psalm: **It is your face, O Lord, that I seek.**

Gospel Acclamation: **Alleluia, alleluia! The sheep that belong to me listen to my voice, says the Lord, I know them and they follow me. Alleluia!**

Gospel: Matthew 5:27-32

*If a man looks at a woman lustfully, he has already committed adultery.*

Communion Antiphon: **The Lord is my rock, my fortress, and my deliverer; my God is my saving strength.**
