Communion Antiphon: **I resolved to know nothing while I was with you expect Jesus Christ, and him crucified.**

First Reading: Jude 17: 20-25

Responsorial Psalm: **For you my soul is thirsting, O Lord, my God.**

Gospel Acclamation: **Alleluia, alleluia! The word of the Lord remains for ever: What is this word? It is the Good News that has been brought to you. Alleluia!**

Gospel: Mark 11:27-33

What authority have you for acting like this?

First Reading: Apocalypse 21:1-5

Here God Lives among men.

Responsorial Psalm: **How lovely is your dwelling place, Lord, God of hosts.**

Second Reading: 1 Corinthians 3:9-11. 16-17

You are the temple of God.

Gospel Acclamation: **Alleluia, alleluia! I shall make my home among them, says the Lord; I will be their God, they shall be my people. Alleluia!**

Gospel: John 4:19-24
True worshippers will worship the Father in spirit and truth.

The **Creed** is said.

Communion Antiphon: **You are the temple of God, and the Spirit of God dwells in you. The temple of God, which you are, is holy.**

Gospel: Mark 10:28-31
You will be repaid a hundred times over, not without persecutions, now in this present time and, in the world to come, eternal life.

Communion Antiphon: **I will sing to the Lord who has been bountiful with me, sing psalms to the name of the Lord Most High.**

Wednesday, 30th May

You were ransomed in the precious blood of a lamb without spot or stain, namely Christ.

Responsorial Psalm: **O praise the Lord, Jerusalem!**

Gospel Acclamation: **Alleluia, alleluia! When anyone obeys what Christ has said, God's love comes to perfection in him. Alleluia!**

Gospel: Mark 10:32-45
Now we are going up to Jerusalem and the Son of Man is about to be handed over.

Communion Antiphon: **I will sing to the Lord who has been bountiful with me, sing psalms to the name of the Lord Most High.**

Thursday, 31st May

**THE VISITATION OF
THE BLESSED VIRGIN MARY**

Entrance Antiphon: **Come and hear, all who fear God; I will tell what the Lord did for my soul.**

The **Gloria** is said.

First Reading: Zephaniah 3:14-18
The Lord, the king of Israel, is in your midst.

Alternative First Reading: Romans 12:9-16
If any of the saints are in need you must share with them; and you should make hospitality your special care.

Responsorial Psalm: **Great in your midst is the Holy One of Israel.**

Gospel Acclamation: **Alleluia, alleluia! Blessed is the Virgin Mary who believed that the promise made her by the Lord would be fulfilled. Alleluia!**

Gospel: Luke 1:39-56
Why should I be honoured with a visit from the mother of my Lord?

Communion Antiphon: **All generations will call me blessed, for he who is mighty has done great things of me, and holy is his name.**
