Entrance Antiphon: **My heart will rejoice in your salvation. I will sing to the Lord, who has been bountiful with me.**

*The Gospel is proper to this memorial*

First Reading: 2 Timothy 3:10-17  
*Anybody who tries to live in devotion to Christ is certain to be attacked.*

Responsorial Psalm: **My heart exults in the Lord my saviour.**

Gospel Acclamation: **Alleluia, alleluia! Blessed is the Virgin Mary who treasured the word of God, and pondered it in her heart. Alleluia!**

Gospel: Mark 12:35-37  
*How can they maintain that the Christ is the son of David?*

Communion Antiphon: **To you I call, for you will surely heed me, O God; turn your ear to me; hear my words.**

**Monday, 4<sup>th</sup> June**

**Weekday**

Entrance Antiphon: **Turn to me and have mercy on me, O Lord, for I am alone and poor. See my lowliness and suffering and take away all my sins, my God.**

First Reading: 2 Peter 1:2-7  
*He has given us the guarantee of something very great: to be able to share the divine nature.*

Responsorial Psalm: **My God, in you I trust.**

Gospel Acclamation: **Alleluia, alleluia! Let the message of Christ, in all its richness, find a home with you; through him give thanks to God the Father. Alleluia!**

Gospel: Mark 12:1-12  
*They seized the beloved son and killed him and threw him out of the vineyard.*

Communion Antiphon: **To you I call, for you will surely heed me, O God; turn your ear to me; hear my words.**

**Tuesday, 5<sup>th</sup> June**

**St Boniface, Bishop and Martyr**

*Born in Devon about 675, Boniface was martyred in the Netherlands in 754. He was a great evangeliser, known as the Apostle of Germany for his missionary zeal and is said to have died whilst ministering the sacrament of Confirmation.*

Entrance Antiphon: **This holy man fought to the death for the law of his God and did not fear the words of the godless, for he was built on solid rock.**

First Reading: 2 Peter 3:11-15. 17-18  
*We are waiting for the new heavens and the new earth.*

Responsorial Psalm: **O Lord, you have been our refuge from one generation to the next.**

Gospel Acclamation: **Alleluia, alleluia! The word of God is something alive and active; it can judge secret emotions and thoughts. Alleluia!**

Gospel: Mark 12:13-17  
*Give back to Caesar what belongs to Caesar – and to God what belongs to God.*

Communion Antiphon: **Whoever wishes to come after me, must deny himself, take up his cross, and follow me, says the Lord.**

### Wednesday, 6<sup>th</sup> June

Weekday or

**St Norbert, Bishop**

*Born in Germany in 1080, Norbert assiduously pursued a life of empty pleasures. Around 1115 he had a conversion experience, which changed his life: he became a priest and began preaching. The manner of his life attracted others to accompany him, and the Premonstratensian (or Norbertine) Order was begun. He later became an Archbishop and died in 1134.*

Entrance Antiphon: **Turn to me and have mercy on me, O Lord, for I am alone and poor. See my lowliness and suffering and take away all my sins, my God.**

First Reading: 2 Timothy 1:1-3. 6-12  
*Fan into a flame the gift that God gave you when I laid my hands on you.*

Responsorial Psalm: **To you, O Lord, I lift up my eyes.**

Gospel Acclamation: **Alleluia, alleluia! Your word is truth, O Lord, consecrate us in the truth. Alleluia!**

Gospel: Mark 12:18-27  
*He is God, not of the dead, but of the living.*

Communion Antiphon: **To you I call, for you will surely heed me, O God; turn your ear to me; hear my words.**

Thursday, 7<sup>th</sup> June

Weekday

Entrance Antiphon: **Turn to me and have mercy on me, O Lord, for I am alone and poor. See my lowliness and suffering and take away all my sins, my God.**

First Reading: 2 Timothy 2:8-15  
*They cannot chain up God's news. If we have died with him, then we shall live with him.*

Responsorial Psalm: **Lord, make me know your ways.**

Gospel Acclamation: **Alleluia, alleluia! Your words are spirit, Lord, and they are life: you have the message of eternal life. Alleluia!**

Gospel: Mark 12:28-34  
*This is the first commandment. The second is like it.*

Communion Antiphon: **To you I call, for you will surely heed me, O God; turn your ear to me; hear my words.**

### Friday, 8<sup>th</sup> June

**THE MOST SACRED HEART OF JESUS**

Entrance Antiphon: **The designs of his Heart are from age to age, to rescue their souls from death, and to keep them alive in famine.**

The **Gloria** is said.

First Reading: Hosea 11:1. 3-4. 8-9  
*My heart recoils from it.*

Responsorial Psalm: **With joy you will draw water from the wells of the Saviour.**

Second Reading Ephesians 3:8-12. 14-19  
*The love of Christ is beyond all knowledge.*

Gospel Acclamation: **Alleluia, alleluia! Shoulder my yoke and learn from me, for I am gentle and humble in heart. Alleluia!**

Gospel: John 19:31-37  
*One of the soldiers pierced his side and there came out blood and water.*

The **Creed** is said.
