New Feast of Our Lady

The Vatican has declared a new feast day in honour of the Virgin Mary.

The Monday after Pentecost will mark the "Memorial of the Blessed Virgin Mary, Mother of the Church," according to the Vatican's decree. The feast day will fall on May 21 this year.

"Mary is at once Mother of Christ, the Son of God, and mother of the members of his Mystical Body, which is the Church," the decree said. "These considerations derive from the divine motherhood of Mary and from her intimate union in the work of the Redeemer, which culminated at the hour of the cross."
