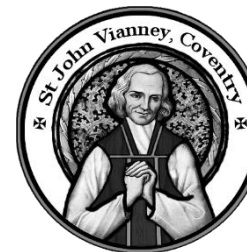

WORLD DAY OF PRAYER FOR COMMUNICATIONS: Today we pray for the work of the Church in proclaiming the Good News of Jesus Christ.
