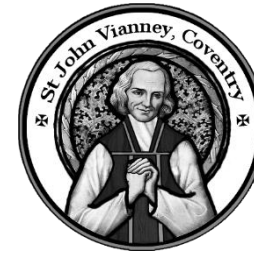

The review is being conducted by an independent charity called SCIE (Social Care Institute for Excellence).
