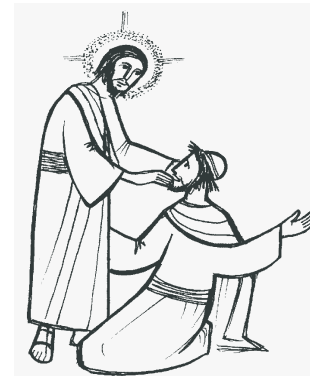

**" He makes the deaf hear and the dumb speak."
(Mk. 7:37)**

Dear Parishioners, in today's gospel we can see how Jesus cures a gentile man who is deaf and has a speech impediment. In Mark's mind Jesus was fulfilling the prophecy of Isaiah as we will hear in the 1st reading: "The ears of the deaf will be unsealed and the tongues of the dumb sing for joy." In other words, Jesus is the one who bring salvation to the world. We are not deaf or dumb. We can hear and speak clearly; however we often close our ears and our tongues to God's words and to the Church. In that way we become deaf and dumb in spirit. Let us ask God to touch our ears to hear his word and our tongues to profess our faith as he did for the deaf man in today's gospel.

NEW BOILERS: We have now received the final invoices from the plumbers for the replacement boilers the final total figure (which included the hiring of the fan heaters to cover the period whilst we had no heat) was £20,750.61 of this bill the insurance company have paid £4,328.62. As a Parish, through donations and 2nd collections and through Fr Louis' generously donating 50% of this salary this year, we have raised a further **£7,245.80** Therefore the balance outstanding on the boilers now stands at **£9,176.64.**
