The Sunday Readings

Isaiah speaks clearly of a coming time of God's arrival when creation will be transformed. The blind shall see,

the deaf hear, the lame leap, the dumb sing for joy. Rivers will burst into the deserts, scorched earth be lakes and parched lands, springs. Life will be changed. In Jesus, we see all that fulfilled. His healing miracles (in today's gospel it is the deaf and dumb man who hears and speaks) are a sign of God's kingdom come among us., the transforming power of God come to release healing, wholeness, plenty and new life. Jesus is not just the sign of all that, but the way to it. The defeat of sickness and disability is but a foretaste of the defeat of the last great sickness of all—death. Death, the consequence of our disobedience of God, comes to be abolished by God in Jesus, and replaced by new life, the life of the risen Christ offered to all who follow Him.

HAIL CROSS, our hope; on thee we call

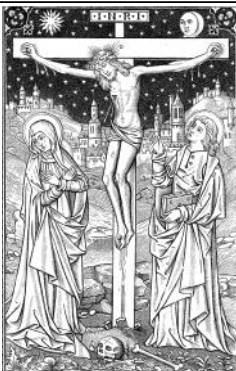

ARRANGING A BAPTISM

(CHRISTENING) for BABIES & YOUNG CHILDREN

Congratulations on the birth of your child! Baptism is arranged by appointment. It usually happens at 12.15 p.m. on a Sunday **or** at either Sunday Mass. Parents should collect a form **after Sunday Mass**. For the baptism of children over four and of adults see the parish priest.

MAKING YOUR CONFESSION

Our God is a God of mercy! Confession, the sacrament of reconciliation, is available on Saturday mornings 9.40 a.m.-10.20 a.m., on Sundays before 6 p.m. Mass and by arrangement with the parish priest.

ADORING THE LORD: EXPOSITION

There are regular opportunities each week to pray before the Blessed Sacrament exposed on the altar. Saturdays from 9.30 a.m. (following Mass) and Mondays 7.00 p.m.
