#### HARVEST FESTIVAL

This year's Harvest Festival will take place next weekend, 13<sup>th</sup>/14<sup>th</sup> October. If you would like to help we are asking people to donate items of food which we will share between local charities that support the homeless and vulnerable in our community: Anesis, Carriers of Hope, The City Mission, Cyrenians, God's Café and Grub 'n' Gab.

The following items are regularly needed: tea, coffee, sugar, long-life milk, tinned meat and tuna for sandwiches, pasta, rice, tinned fruit and vegetables, etc. Fresh fruit and vegetables can also be donated but only on the weekend of the Harvest Festival itself. Thank you for your generous support throughout the year.

The following items are also needed by one of the homeless charities: tinned soup, biscuits, small size chocolate bars/cakes, packets of instant custard, kitchen roll, small salt and pepper pots, tea towels.
