The Coventry Deanery is one of eighteen Deaneries which make up the Catholic Archdiocese of Birmingham. The Coventry Deanery has the following parishes: All Souls, Christ the King and Our Lady of Lourdes with St Augustine's, Corpus Christi with St Anne's, Holy Family, Our Lady of the Assumption, Sacred Heart, St Elizabeth, St John Fisher, St John Vianney, St Joseph the Worker, St Mary and St Benedict with St Osburg's, St Patrick, St Thomas More. Also within the Deanery is the Ordinariate based at St Joseph the Worker, and Chaplaincies at University Hospital Trust and at Coventry and Warwick Universities.



Welcome to our first Coventry Deanery Newsletter. We hope to produce three editions a year (Summer, Christmas, Easter) to keep you up to date with all that is happening in the Deanery and to let you know what is going on in each of the parishes so that parishes can begin to work more closely together and to offer some opportunities

jointly.

In this edition we are letting you know about opportunities that will be available from September. There is a list of Parish Youth Groups, so that young people can attend groups outside of their own Parish. Parishes are organising "Talks on the Faith" and again, these are available to the wider community outside of the Parish.

There are Deanery events to mark 1000 years of St Osburg and details of these events are included in this edition.

The Deanery is also organising a "Sowing the Seeds" Course for Parish Catechists, Teachers and anyone who wants to improve their knowledge of the faith. This will begin in October for twelve weeks, again details are included in this edition.

We hope to organise regular Deanery trips to all the Diocesan Pilgrimages and to share coaches between parishes.

In my visits to each of the parishes over the last few months I have seen how much good work goes on in each of the parishes and it may be a neighbouring parish has something to interest you. Our parishes will be working more closely together and it is important for us to know what our deanery has to offer. In future editions we will look at our schools and ways in which the deanery can organise pilgrimages and events together. If there are other events or opportunities that you would like to share with the Deanery, please let me know.
