We shall look at some of the large collection of stereo photographic cards of Warwickshire held in the Warwickshire County Record Office and compare them with our world today. Of particular interest are the WWII destroyed features of Coventry and its Cathedrals recorded largely in the 1860s. Mid-19th century images of Kenilworth Castle also provide some interesting reflections.

There will be an interval for refreshments and then the second part will be a presentation of short audio visual shows revealing some of the wonders of the natural world revealed in 3-D.
