"Most Precious Blood of Jesus, Our Lord, cry for mercy for us to Thy Divine Father, and deliver us from all evil.

Spare, O Lord, spare Thy people whom Thou hast redeemed with Thy Precious Blood. Eternal Father, sign us with the Blood of the Immaculate Lamb, as Thou didst sign the dwellings of Thy People."

We celebrate our own special feast, the Feast of the Precious Blood, on Saturday 1st July, with a simple Mass followed by the pitching of tents. It is intended that our celebration of the Precious Blood should spill over onto Sunday with a special Festival Mass at 11.15 am and with eating and drinking in the Presbytery Garden.

Please bring food to share. Drinks provided. Food to be left please in the Parish Room before 11.15am Mass. The 9.30am Mass will be a 'short quiet' Mass. There will be a Special Raffle to raise funds for our school currently suffering from austerity and reduced budgets.
