Marie's Requiem is in Corpus Christi on Wednesday 25th October at 10.30am. Reception the night before at 5.00pm.

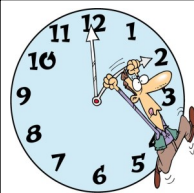

Ministers of the Word, Readers

The ministry of Reader in the Church is a very important one, it is therefore important that we do our best in proclaiming God's Word. Proclaiming is very different from reading. It is important to use the microphone properly. Adjust the microphone to your height and speak clearly and slowly into it. Remember, announce and more diction. Try to speak louder than your normal speaking voice. Project your voice. The microphones can only do so much. Don't try and fit whole sentences in one breathe just because there is no comma. By slowing down at key words the sentence takes on a whole different meaning.

If you are reading the Psalm, remember that we may not have the words in front of us to the response especially during the week. The Reader needs to lead the Response to the Psalm each time after the verse. It is not always easy to catch the response first time. If the people aren't joining in, then help them, lead them, in an audible voice.
