"His face shone like the sun."

(Mt.17:2).

Dear brothers and sisters, in today's gospel, Matthew reports to us that Jesus went with his three loving disciples: Peter, James and John. He was transfigured in their present, his face shone like the sun, and his clothing became as white as the light. Moses and Elijah were talking with him. Then the voice came from the cloud saying: *this is my Son, the Chosen One, listen to him*. Peter, James and John had a wonderful experience on mount Tabor, they saw the glory of Jesus' transfiguration. This event encouraged them and helped them to follow Jesus' footsteps until the end of their lives. Being Christians, like the disciples, we will admire Jesus' glory and our souls will be transformed if we unite with God and perform his teaching. However our sins disfigure us and tarnish the image of God in us. Let us ask for God's grace and strength, so that our lives may be transformed so that in turn we may transform the world.
