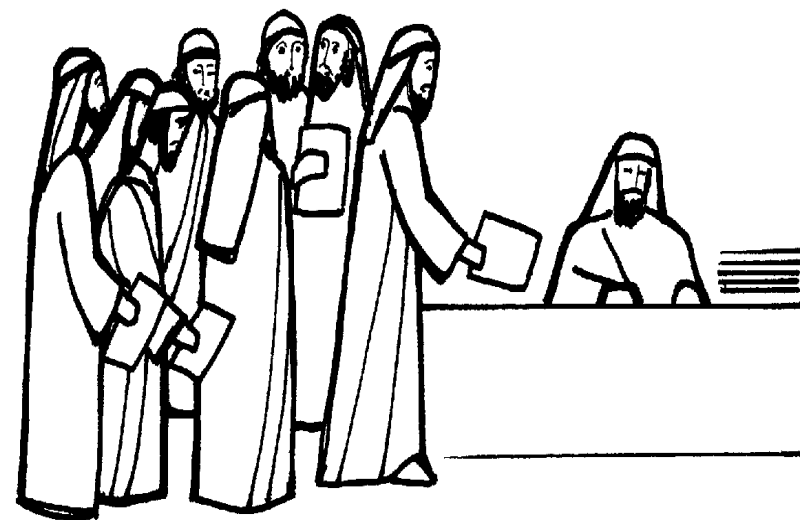

(Lc.16:9)

Dear Parishioners, in today's gospel Jesus teaches his disciples and us how to use money and he says, "you cannot be the slave both of God and of money." He doesn't want us to worship money but to use it as a means to serve God in others and to store our heavenly treasure. Jesus praises the steward for his astuteness, because he clearly knows how to prepare for his future.
