FROM FATHER MICHAEL

The Ten Commandments, the very foundation of the Moral Law, the very heart of the revelation to Moses in the Old Testament and arguably the basis of much of our civil law, but what part do they play in your life, and what do they really mean? And for that matter how much have we departed from them? Meanwhile Jesus comes along, enters the Temple in Jerusalem, the very heart of the Jewish religion, and initiates a protest movement. How should we protest against injustice and corruption? Is violence ever justified, and if so what sort of violence? This is Passover time, when the Jews will be saved by the blood of the lambs on the doorposts. What statement is Jesus making here? Or is he just mad and foolish? Or there again maybe this very madness and foolishness is the very madness and foolishness of God Himself.
