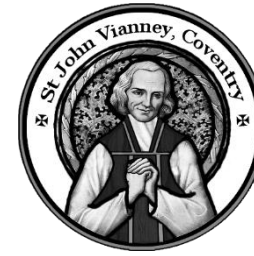

Today we celebrate the fiftieth day of Easter and the great Solemnity of Pentecost when we rejoice in the gift of the Holy Spirit which the Risen Lord poured out upon His Church. FIRST HOLY COMMUNION: This Sunday we rejoice with the children and families of our community who will receive Our Blessed Lord in Holy Communion for the very first time. We rejoice in the gift of Christ to us in the Holy Eucharist and through this special celebration we renew our love and dedication to this most wonderful Sacrament. Please pray for the children and their families that the gift given to them today for the first time will be loved and adored by them throughout their lives.

EASTER DUTIES: Today marks the final day of the Season of Easter. The time for making Easter duties ends next Sunday, the Feast of the Holy Trinity. If you have not been to confession recently, take the plunge and become bathed in the mercy and love of God!
