Year for Priests June 2018-2019

The Solemnity of the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus marks the start of the year of thanksgiving, prayer and celebration for the priests in the Archdiocese of Birmingham to the Feast of Sacred Heart in 2019. This year marks the 450 anniv. of the foundation of the English College, Douai, the first institution to form priests for the mission in England after the reformation. From Douai, colleges were founded across France, Spain, Portugal and in Rome. These colleges trained the priests, without whom Catholicism would almost certainly have died out in England and Wales. For generations, priests in England and Wales, were treated as traitors and lived under cover in fear of their lives; hundreds were martyred. Without their resilience and courage, the Catholic Church we have today would not exist.

This year is a time to thank God for the priests of today, as well as to celebrate the past. We also remember the Religious Missionaries Priests who were sent over to England and Wales for mission. In our parish, let us please remember and pray for the Religious priests from the Order of the Apostles of Jesus, who have been serving this parish for the last 16 years - through Fr Aloysius, Fr John and Fr Moses. This year also marks 50th year of their foundation as an Order.

We are all encouraged to pray for all the priests and particularly of this Archdiocese, and for vocation to the priesthood. Prayer cards are at the back of the church for you to take and use in your daily prayer for priests.
