GDPR - SICK LIST

If your name or the name of a friend or relative is on the parish list of prayers for those who are sick and would like that name to remain on the list, **you will need to pick up a consent form from the piety stall**. We need to make sure the sick person has consented to their name being on the list. This is because the list can be seen by a lot of people as it is on the church newsletter and on the Deanery website. **In a couple of weeks' time the list will be re-started with only the names of those for whom the parish has consent**. This is necessary to make sure the Church takes proper care of your information and complies with current data protection law.
