VISIT OF THE ORDINARIES OF THE ORDINARIATE OF THE CHAIR OF SAINT PETER (USA & CANADA) AND THE ORDINARIATE OF OUR LADY OF THE SOUTHERN (AUSTRALIA) From 13th-18th October Bishop Steven Lopes and Mgr. Harry Entwistle will be in England to meet with Mgr Newton. On Monday the 15th, the Friends of the Ordinariate of Our Lady of Walsingham has organised an event in Our Lady of the Assumption Warwick Street which will take the form of a lecture given by Fr Ignatius Harrison Cong. Orat, the Provost of the Birmingham Oratory. He will be speaking on the subject of "Blessed John Henry Newman: Our Guide for Tomorrow." This will be followed by a question and answer session with Bishop Lopes, Mgr. Entwistle and Mgr Newton. There will be a reception afterwards. The tickets for the reception are £20 per head, available beforehand by sending a cheque to the Friends of the Ordinariate at 24 Golden Square, London, W1F 9JR. They may be purchased on the evening for £25. From the 16th to the 17th, the three Ordinaries will make a short pilgrimage to Walsingham. Clergy of the UK ordinariate have been invited to join them, including for a celebratory dinner. Both Father Paul and Father Tim will be present (there have to be some perks!). Please let us know if you have any prayer intentions which you would like us to bring to Our Lady's Shrine. We will of course pray for you all and for the unity of the Church.

DOWRY TOUR OF OUR LADY OF WALSINGHAM. The statue of Our Lady of Walsingham is currently travelling around the country in preparation for the rededication of England as Our Lady's Dowry in 2020. The statue and the exhibition will be visiting Our Lady of the Assumption Warwick Street from the 28th to the 30th of March next year. There will be a number of arranged activities and it is hoped to have an ecumenical event, inviting Anglicans with a devotion to Our Lady of Walsingham.

10th ANNIVERSARY SYMPOSIUM IN ROME To mark the 10th anniversary of *Anglicanorum Coetibus*, the Apostolic Constitution of Pope Benedict XVI, which provides for Personal Ordinariates for Anglicans to enter into full communion with the Catholic Church, the three ordinariates are planning a symposium in Rome between 4th and 8th November 2019. Members of the ordinariates are encouraged to attend, so if you are interested, please put the dates firmly in your diary. It would be wonderful if a group of us could be there together.
