

First Reading: Genesis 37:3-4. 17-28

Responsorial Psalm: **Remember the wonders the Lord has done.**

Gospel Acclamation: **Praise and honour to you, Lord Jesus! God loved the world so much that he gave his only Son; everyone who believes in him has eternal life. Praise and honour to you, Lord Jesus!**

Gospel: Matthew 21:33-43.45-46

This is the heir. Come on, let us kill him

Communion Antiphon: **God loved us, and sent his Son as expiation for our sins.**

Saturday, 23rd March

Weekday of Lent or Comm. of St Turibius, Bishop

Turibius was born in Mayorga (Spain) in 1538 and worked for many years as a professor of law at Salamanca. In 1580, even though still a layman, he was appointed Archbishop of Lima in Peru. He was the champion of the rights of indigenous people and did much to consolidate ecclesiastical discipline. He died in 1606.

Entrance Antiphon: **The Lord is kind and full of compassion, slow to anger, abounding in mercy. How good is the Lord to all, compassionate to all his creatures.**

First Reading: Micah 7:14-15. 18-20

Tread down our faults to the bottom of the sea.

Responsorial Psalm: **The Lord is compassion and love.**

Gospel Acclamation: **Glory and praise to you, O Christ! I will leave this place and go to my father and say: 'Father, I have sinned against heaven and against you.' Glory and praise to you, O Christ!**

Gospel: Luke 15:1-3. 11-32

Your brother here was dead and has come to life.

Communion Antiphon: **You must rejoice, my son, for your brother was dead and has come to life; he was lost and is found.**

Monday, 18th March

Weekday in Lent

Comm. St. Cyril of Jerusalem, Bishop and Doctor of the Church

Cyril was born in 315. He became Bishop of Jerusalem in 348. A great teacher, he instructed adults during Lent on a daily basis. He died in 386.

Entrance Antiphon: **Redeem me, O Lord, and have mercy on me. My foot stands on level ground; I will bless the Lord in the assembly.**

First Reading: Daniel 9:4-10

We have sinned, we have done wrong.

Responsorial Psalm: **Do not treat us according to our sins, O Lord.**

Gospel Acclamation: **Praise and honour to you, Lord Jesus! The seed is the word of God, Christ the sower, whoever finds this seed will remain for ever. Praise and honour to you, Lord Jesus!**

Gospel: Luke 6:36-38

Grant pardon, and you will be pardoned.

Communion Antiphon: **Be merciful, as your Father is merciful, says the Lord.**

Tuesday, 19th March

**SAINT JOSEPH, SPOUSE OF THE BLESSED
VIRGIN MARY**

What is known about Joseph is to be found in the Gospels. Devotion to him spread slowly and in the West is mainly due to the influence of St Teresa of Avila in the 16th century. He is Patron of the Universal Church, fathers, carpenters, bursars, manual labourers, and of a holy death.

Entrance Antiphon: **Behold, a faithful and prudent steward, whom the Lord set over his household.**

The **Gloria** is said.

First Reading: 2 Samuel 7:4-5. 12-14. 16
The Lord God will give him the throne of his ancestor David.

Responsorial Psalm: **His dynasty shall last for ever.**

Second Reading: Romans 4:13. 16-18. 22
Though it seemed Abraham's hope could not be fulfilled, he hoped and he believed.

Gospel Acclamation: **Glory and praise to you, O Christ! They are happy who dwell in your house, O Lord, for ever singing your praise. Glory and praise to you, O Christ!**

Gospel: Matthew 1:16. 18-24. 24
Joseph did what the angel of the Lord told him to do.

Alternative Gospel: Luke 2:41-51
See how worried your father and I have been, looking for you.

The **Creed** is said.

Communion Antiphon: **Well done, good and faithful servant. Come, share your master's joy.**

Wednesday, 20th March

Weekday in Lent

Entrance Antiphon: **Forsake me not, O Lord! My God, be not far from me! Make haste and come to my help, O Lord, my strong salvation!**

First Reading: Jeremiah 18:18-20
Come on, let us hit at him.

Responsorial Psalm: **Save me in your love, O Lord.**

Gospel Acclamation: **Glory to you, O Christ, you are the Word of God! Your words are spirit, Lord, and they are life; you have the message of eternal life. Glory to you, O Christ, you are the Word of God!**

Gospel: Matthew 20:17-28
They will condemn him to death.

Communion Antiphon: **The Son of Man did not come to be served but to serve, and to give his life as a ransom for many.**

Thursday, 21st March

Weekday in Lent

Entrance Antiphon: **Test me, O God, and know my thoughts. See that my path is not wicked, and lead me in the way everlasting.**

First Reading: Jeremiah 17:5-10
A curse on the man who puts his trust in man, a blessing on the man who puts his trust in the Lord.

Responsorial Psalm: **Happy the man who has placed his trust in the Lord.**

Gospel Acclamation: **Praise to you, O Christ, king of eternal glory! I will leave this place and go to my father and say: 'Father, I have sinned against heaven and against you.' Praise to you, O Christ, king of eternal glory!**

Gospel: Luke 16:19-31
Good things came your way, just as bad things came the way of Lazarus. Now he is being comforted here while you are in agony.

Communion Antiphon: **Blessed are those whose way is blameless, who walk in the law of the Lord.**

Friday 22nd March

Weekday in Lent

Entrance Antiphon: **In you, O Lord, I put my trust, let me never be put to shame; release me from the snares they have hidden from me, for you indeed are my refuge.**

The **Gloria** is said.
