

Gospel: Mark 12:28-34

Communion Antiphon: **To love God with all your heart, and your neighbour as yourself, is worth more than any sacrifice.**

Saturday, 30th March

Weekday in Lent

Entrance Antiphon: **Bless the Lord, O my soul, and never forget all his benefits; it is he who forgives all your sins.**

First Reading: Hosea 5:15 – 6:6
What I want is love, not sacrifice.

Responsorial Psalm: **What I want is love, not sacrifice.**

Gospel Acclamation: **Glory and praise to you, O Christ! Harden not your hearts today, but listen to the voice of the Lord. Glory and praise to you, O Christ!**

Gospel: Luke 18:9-14
The tax collector went home again at rights with God; the Pharisee did not.

Communion Antiphon: **The tax collector stood at a distance, beating his breast and saying: O God, be merciful to me, a sinner.**

Monday, 25th March

THE ANNUNCIATION OF THE LORD



Entrance Antiphon: **The Lord said, as he entered the world: Behold, I come to do your will, O God.**

The **Gloria** is said.

First Reading: Isaiah 7:10-14. 8:10
The maiden is with child.

Responsorial Psalm: **Here I am, Lord! I come to do your will.**

Second Reading: Hebrews 10:4-10
I was commanded in the scroll of the book, 'God, here I am! I am coming to obey your will.'

Gospel Acclamation: **Praise to you O Christ, king of eternal glory! The Word was made flesh, he lived among us, and we saw his glory. Praise to you, O Christ, king of eternal glory.**

Gospel: Luke 1:26-38
You are to conceive and bear a son.

The **Creed** is said.

Communion Antiphon: **Behold, a Virgin shall conceive and bear a son; and his name will be called Emmanuel.**

Tuesday, 26th March

Weekday in Lent

Entrance Antiphon: To you I call, for you will surely heed me, O God; turn your ear to me; hear my words. Guard me as the apple of your eye; in the shadow of your wings protect me.

First Reading: Daniel 3:25. 34-43
May the contrite soul, the humbled spirit be acceptable to you.

Responsorial Psalm: Remember your mercy, Lord.

Gospel Acclamation: Glory and praise to you, O Christ! Blessed are those who, with a noble and generous heart, take the word of God to themselves and yield a harvest through their perseverance. Glory and praise to you, O Christ!

Gospel: Matthew 18:21-35
Your Father will not forgive you unless you each forgive your brother from your heart.

Communion Antiphon: Lord, who may abide in your tent, and dwell on your holy mountain? Whoever walks without fault and does what is just.

Wednesday, 27th March

Weekday in Lent

Entrance Antiphon: Let my steps be guided by your promise; may evil never rule me.

First Reading: Deuteronomy 4:1. 5-9
Take notice of the laws and observe them.

Responsorial Psalm: O praise the Lord, Jerusalem!

Gospel Acclamation: Glory to you, O Christ, you are the Word of God! I am the light of the world, says the Lord, anyone who follows me will have the light of life. Glory to you, O Christ, you are the Word of God!

Gospel: Matthew 5:17-19
The man who keeps these commandments and teaches them will be considered great in the kingdom of heaven.

Communion Antiphon: You will show me the path of life, the fullness of joy in your presence, O Lord.

Thursday, 28th March

Weekday in Lent

Entrance Antiphon: I am the salvation of the people, says the Lord. Should they cry to me in any distress, I will hear them, and I will be their Lord for ever.

First Reading: Jeremiah 7:23-28
Here is the nation that will not listen to the voice of the Lord its God.

Responsorial Psalm: O that today you would listen to his voice! 'Harden not your hearts.'

Gospel Acclamation: Praise to you, O Christ, king of eternal glory! Shake off all your sins – it is the Lord who speaks – and make yourselves a new heart and a new spirit. Praise to you, O Christ, king of eternal glory!

Gospel: Luke 11:14-23
He who is not with me is against me.

Communion Antiphon: You have laid down your precepts to be carefully kept; may my ways be firm in keeping your statutes.

Friday, 29th March

Weekday in Lent

Entrance Antiphon: Among the gods there is none like you, O Lord, for you are great and do marvellous deeds; you alone are God.

First Reading: Hosea 14:2-10
We will not say any more, 'Our God' to what our own hands have made.

Responsorial Psalm: I am the Lord your God; listen to my warning.

Gospel Acclamation: Praise and honour to your, Lord Jesus! The seed is the word of God, Christ the sower; whoever finds this seed will remain for ever. Praise and honour to you, Lord Jesus!
