Communion Antiphon: **In Christ, we have redemption by his blood, and forgiveness of our sins, in accord with the riches of his grace.**

Saturday, 6th April

Weekday of Lent

Entrance Antiphon: **The waves of death rose about me; the pains of the netherworld surrounded me. In my anguish I called to the Lord, and from his holy temple he heard my voice.**

First Reading: Jeremiah 11:18-20

I was like a trustful lamb being led to the slaughter-house.

Responsorial Psalm: **Lord God, I take refuge in you.**

Gospel Acclamation: **Praise and honour to you, Lord Jesus! I take pleasure, not in the death of a wicked man – it is the Lord who speaks – but in the turning back of a wicked man who changes his ways to win life. Praise and honour to you, Lord Jesus!**

Gospel: John 7:40-52

Would the Christ be from Galilee?

Communion Antiphon: **By the precious Blood of Christ, the Blood of a spotless and unblemished Lamb, we have been redeemed.**

Monday, 1st April

Weekday of Lent

Entrance Antiphon: **As for me, I trust in the Lord. Let me be glad and rejoice in your mercy, for you have seen my affliction.**

First Reading: Isaiah 65:17-21

No more will the sound of weeping or the sound of cries be heard.

Responsorial Psalm: **I will praise you, Lord, you have rescued me.**

Gospel Acclamation: **Praise and honour to you, Lord Jesus! My soul is waiting for the Lord, I count on his word, because with the Lord there is mercy and fullness of redemption. Praise and honour to you, Lord Jesus!**

Gospel: John 4:43-54

Go home, your son will live.

Communion Antiphon: **I will place my spirit within you and make you walk according to my laws; and my judgements you shall keep and observe, says the Lord.**

Tuesday, 2nd April

Weekday of Lent

Comm. Of St Francis of Paola, Hermit

Francis was born in Italy in 1416. He founded a congregation of hermits following the ideal of St Francis of Assisi. He is remembered as a true reformer of the Church. He died in 1507 in Tours, France.

Entrance Antiphon: **All who are thirsty, come to the waters, says the Lord. Though you have no money, come and drink with joy.**

First Reading: Ezekiel 47: 1-9. 12
I saw a stream of water coming from the Temple, bringing life to all wherever it flowed.

Responsorial Psalm: **The Lord of hosts is with us: the God of Jacob is our stronghold.**

Gospel Acclamation: **Praise and honour to you, Lord Jesus! A pure heart create for me, O God, and give me again the joy of your help. Praise and honour to you, Lord Jesus!**

Gospel: John 5:1-3. 5-16
The man was cured at once.

Communion Antiphon: **The Lord is my shepherd; there is nothing I shall want. Fresh and green are the pastures where he gives me repose, near restful waters he leads me.**

Wednesday, 3rd April

Weekday of Lent

Entrance Antiphon: **I pray to you, O Lord, for a time of your favour. In your great mercy, answer me, O God, with your salvation that never fails.**

First Reading: Isaiah 49:8-15
I have appointed you as covenant of the people to restore the land.

Responsorial Psalm: **The Lord is kind and full of compassion.**

Gospel Acclamation: **Glory and praise to you, O Christ! God loved the world so much that he gave his only Son; everyone who believes in him has eternal life. Glory and praise to you, O Christ!**

Gospel: John 5:17-30
As the Father raises the dead and gives them life, so the Son gives life to those he chooses.

Communion Antiphon: **God did not send his Son into the world to judge the world, but that the world might be saved through him.**

Thursday, 4th April

Weekday of Lent

**Comm. Of St Isidore,
bishop and doctor of the Church**

Isidore died in 636, age 76. He lived in turbulent times in the Church in Spain. Isidore reunited Spain, making it a centre of culture and learning, a teacher and guide for other European countries. Born in Cartagena of a family that included three other saints, he was educated by his elder brother, whom he succeeded as bishop of Seville. An

amazingly learned man, he was sometimes called "The Schoolmaster of the Middle Ages." Isidore is the Patron of computers and the Internet.

Entrance Antiphon: **Let the hearts that seek the Lord rejoice; turn to the Lord and his strength; constantly seek his face.**

First Reading: Exodus 32:7-14
Do not bring this disaster on your people.

Responsorial Psalm: **O Lord, remember me out of the love you have for your people.**

Gospel Acclamation: **Glory to you, O Christ, you are the Word of God! Your words are spirit, Lord, and they are life; you have the message of eternal life. Glory to you, O Christ, you are the Word of God!**

Gospel: John 5:31-47
You place your hope in Moses, and Moses will be your accuser.

Communion Antiphon: **I will place my law within them, and I will write it upon their hearts; and I will be their God, and they shall be my people, says the Lord.**

Friday, 5th April

Weekday of Lent

Comm. Of St Vincent Ferrer, Priest

Vincent was born in Spain in 1350. He was a Dominican renowned as a teacher and preacher, gaining celebrity status. He died in 1419.

Entrance Antiphon: **O God, save me by your name; by your power, defend my cause. O God, hear my prayer; give ear to the words of my mouth.**

First Reading: Wisdom 2:1. 12-22
Let us condemn him to a shameful death.

Responsorial Psalm: **The Lord is close to the broken hearted.**

Gospel Acclamation: **Praise to you O Christ, king of eternal glory. Now, now – it is the Lord who speaks – come back to me with all your heart, for I am all tenderness and compassion. Praise to you, O Christ, king of eternal glory.**
