The conversion of Paul the Apostle, Feast day Friday 25th January



The Conversion of St. Paul (Saul) was, according to the New Testament, an event in the life of Paul (Saul) the Apostle that led him to cease persecuting early Christians and to become a follower of Jesus.

Saul was on the road from Jerusalem to Damascus to arrest certain members of the followers of Jesus when there was a sudden bright light which threw Saul from his horse and blinded him. A voice from the light said to Saul "Saul, Saul why are you persecuting me?"

This event changed Saul's life. Let us ask God to send his light upon us that we too may become more ardent lovers of Christ and the faith.

We remember Sr. Josephine, Sr. Anne and Sr Brigid from Corpus Christ Convent and their community of the Sisters of Charity of St. Paul in a special way this week as they mark their feast.

Corpus Christi Community Hall/Centre - the next stage

The following next steps are recommended on the basis of the Developed Option with Extended Garden being taken forward. These recommendations are determined by identifying the greatest risks to the project and mitigation of these, where possible:

1. Funding -

Development of an initial funding strategy will identify potential funding sources, and will determine the extent of information required for applications to different funders. First stage submissions may be appropriate. The Church is to discuss this with the Archdiocese.

2. Business Plan -

The Church should develop a business plan to inform the scale of development appropriate for the church's use and income generation. This would input into funding applications.

3. Survey-Appraisal

- An appraisal should be undertaken of what additional surveys may be required e.g. ground survey for the location of the culverted stream, and drainage affecting the detail or cost of the proposals.

4. Costs & Design Development -

A cost plan is required to determine costs of the preferred proposal. An indicative cost plan could be developed based on the current drawings. A more detailed cost plan would need to be based on a more developed design, including elevations and 3D. This level of design development would also be required for submission of a planning application.

5. Consultants

- Appointments would need to be considered for other consultants and / or specialists, including Principal Designer to comply with CDM Regulations, Quantity Surveyor, and Building Services Consultant (consideration of heating and ventilation strategies, and the capacity of the existing site).

6. Programme -

A project programme should be drafted, mindful of possible pre-fabrication, and availability of different funding streams.

7. Pre-application Engagement

- Rather than submitting a formal pre-application enquiry, planners could be approached for an informal discussion about the scheme. Once the design has been developed, and there is a delivery plan in place, the proposals should be presented again to project stakeholders, including the congregation, building users, the school, the wider community (in particular those living closest to the development), and the police. The HCC should also be consulted prior to any formal submission.

8. Planning Application -

Once the design has been developed with a more detailed cost plan, and pre-application engagement has taken place, a planning application should be prepared and submitted. Depending on the outcomes of the funding appraisal, first stage applications to some funders may be possible before a planning application is submitted.
