FEAST OF THE PRESENTATION OF THE LORD This Saturday is the feast of the Presentation of the Lord Jesus in the Temple. It commemorates Simeon's famous prophecy that Jesus would be a "light of revelation to the Gentiles." It is also known as Candlemas since it is the day that candles are blessed for use throughout the Church year. Mass is at the usual time of 10am, but beginning in the hall with the Blessing of Candles and Procession.

VISIT OF THE STATUE OF OUR LADY OF WALSINGHAM. In preparation for the rededication of England as Our Lady's dowry, the statue of Our Lady of Walsingham will be touring

English cathedrals over the next 18 months. As part of that tour, the statue will be visiting Our Lady of the Assumption Warwick Street from the 28th to the 30th of March.

DEVOTIONS TO OUR LADY OF WALSINGHAM Our next evening of devotions to Our Lady of Walsingham is on Monday 4th February. This month we will begin with a Mass of Our Lady of Walsingham at 7pm followed by a period of Eucharistic Adoration until 8pm.

CLERGY TEACHING DAY Next week clergy of the ordinariate gather in London for a teaching day. The day will include a talk by Ms Phoebe Prendergast of the Santa Marta Group, who will speak on human trafficking and modern slavery. Fr Martin Halsall, our Director of Formation and Dean of Studies at Allen Hall seminary, will also introduce a wide range of catechetical material for our use. And during the Mass Father David Butler will be making his life profession as a Hermit of the Ordinariate of Our Lady of Walsingham.
