Responsorial Psalm: **Great in your midst is the Holy One of Israel.**

Gospel Acclamation: **Alleluia, alleluia! Blessed is the Virgin Mary who believed that the promise made her by the Lord would be fulfilled. Alleluia!**

Gospel: Luke 1:39-56
Why should I be honoured with a visit from the mother of my Lord?

Communion Antiphon: **All generations will call me blessed, for he who is mighty has done great things of me, and holy is his name, alleluia.**

Saturday 1st June

Weekday in Easter or

St Justin, Martyr

Justin was a renowned thinker, writer and philosopher. He died in 165, a martyr.

Entrance Antiphon: **The wicked tempted me with their fables against your law, but I proclaimed your decrees before kings without fear or shame.**

First Reading: Acts 18:23-28
Apollos demonstrated from the scriptures that Jesus was the Christ.

Responsorial Psalm: **God is king of all the earth.**

Gospel Acclamation: **Alleluia, alleluia! The Lord, who hung for us upon the tree, has risen from the tomb. Alleluia!**

Gospel: John 16:23-28
The Father loves you for loving me and believing.

Communion Antiphon: **I resolved that while I was with you I would think of nothing but Jesus Christ and him crucified.**

Easter Week Six**

Monday, 27th May

ST AUGUSTINE OF CANTERBURY, BISHOP

Augustine was sent by Pope Gregory the Great to establish the Faith in England. Though previous missionaries had evangelised in England, notably the Celtic saints, it was Augustine who has become known as the Apostle of England. He was the first Archbishop of Canterbury. He died in 605. In 2010 this celebration was raised to the rank of Feast.

Entrance Antiphon: **I will praise you, Lord, among the nations; I will tell of your name to my kin, alleluia.**

The **Gloria** is said.

First Reading: 1 Thessalonians 2:2-8
We were eager to hand over not only the Good News but our whole lives as well.

Responsorial Psalm: **Go out to the whole world; proclaim the Good News.**

Gospel Acclamation: **Alleluia, alleluia! The Lord has sent me to bring the good news to the poor, to proclaim liberty to captives. Alleluia!**

Gospel: Luke 10:1-9
The harvest is rich but the labourers are few.

Communion Antiphon: **O chosen people, proclaim the mighty works of him who called you out of darkness, into his wonderful light, alleluia.**

Tuesday 28th May

Weekday in Easter

Entrance Antiphon: **Let us rejoice and be glad and give glory to God, for the Lord our God the Almighty reigns, alleluia.**

First Reading: Acts 16:22-34
Become a believer in the Lord Jesus, and you will be saved, and your household too.

Responsorial Psalm: **You stretch out your hand and save me, O Lord.**

Gospel Acclamation: **Alleluia, alleluia! Christ has risen and shone upon us whom he redeemed with his blood. Alleluia!**

Gospel: John 16:5-11
Unless I go, the Advocate will not come to you.

Communion Antiphon: **The Christ had to suffer and rise from the dead, and so enter into his glory, alleluia.**

Wednesday, 29th May

**SOLEMNITY OF THE DEDICATION
(In consecrated churches)**

Entrance Antiphon: **Greatly to be feared is God in his sanctuary; he, the God of Israel, gives power and strength to his people. Blessed be God!**

The **Gloria** is said.

Responsorial Psalm: **How lovely is your dwelling place, Lord, God of hosts.**

First Reading: Apocalypse 21:1-5
Here God lives among men.

Gospel Acclamation: **Alleluia, alleluia! I shall make my home among them, says the Lord; I will be their God, they shall be my people. Alleluia!**

Gospel: John 4:19-24
True worshippers will worship the Father in spirit and truth.

The **Creed** is said.

Communion Antiphon: **You are the temple of God, and God's Spirit dwells in you. The temple of God is holy. You are that temple.**

**NON CONSECRATED CHURCHES
Weekday in Easter**

Entrance Antiphon: **I will praise you, Lord, among the nations; I will tell of your name to my kin, alleluia.**

First Reading: Acts 17:15,22 – 18:1
The God whom I proclaim is in fact the one whom you already worship without knowing it.

Responsorial Psalm: **Your glory fills all heaven and earth.**

Gospel Acclamation: **Alleluia, alleluia! Since you have been brought back to true life with Christ, you must look for the things that are in heaven where Christ is, sitting at God's right hand. Alleluia!**

Gospel: John 16:12-15
The Spirit of truth will lead you to the complete truth.

Communion Antiphon: **I have chosen you from the world, says the Lord, and have appointed you to go out and bear fruit, fruit that will last, alleluia.**

Thursday, 30th May

SOLEMNITY OF THE ASCENSION

Holy day of Obligation

Entrance Antiphon: **Men of Galilee, why do you gaze in wonder at the heavens? This Jesus whom you saw ascending into Heaven will return as you saw him go, alleluia.**

The **Gloria** is said.

First Reading: Acts 1:1-11
He was lifted up while they looked on.

Responsorial Psalm: **God goes up with shouts of joy; the Lord goes up with trumpet blast.**

Second Reading: Ephesians 1:17-23
He made him sit at his right hand in heaven.
or Hebrews 9:24-28

Gospel Acclamation: **Alleluia, alleluia! Go make disciples of all the nations; I am with you always, even to the end of time. alleluia!**

Gospel: Mark 16:15-20
He was taken up into heaven: there at the right hand of God he took his place.

The **Creed** is said.

Communion Antiphon: **Behold, I am with you always, even to the end of the age, alleluia.**

Friday 31st May

**THE VISITATION OF
THE BLESSED VIRGIN MARY**

Entrance Antiphon: **Come and hear, all who fear God; I will tell what the Lord did for my soul, alleluia.**

The **Gloria** is said.

First Reading: Zephaniah 3:14-18
The Lord, the king of Israel, is in your midst.
