A new rota should have been emailed to you, if you have provided an email address in the past. If you haven't then a hard copy is available at the back of both churches.

Just a reminder; if you are down to exercise your ministry and are unable to be in church that day, then it is your responsibility to find a replacement.

If you are a Reader in Church then it is your responsibility to make sure that you have practiced the Reading several times beforehand, that you have checked that the Reading in the Lectionary is the same reading that is in the Missalettes in Corpus Christi or the books in St. Anne's and that the microphone is switched on.

If you are an Extraordinary Minister of Holy Communion, see that you keep an eye open for people not consuming the Sacred Host. Inform Fr. David: That you return the Ciborium to the Corporal, that is the nine squared cloth at the centre of the Altar. The Ciborium should not be placed outside the Corporal, but on the Corporal.
